

Town of Stratton
Selectman's Meeting
April 13, 2026

Present: Selectman: Al Dupell, Greg Marcucci, Chris Liller and Boomer Walker; Assistant Clerk: Beth Liller; SoVTA rep. – Steve Petrik.

7:55 pm Al Dupell called the meeting to order. Orders were reviewed and signed.

Modifications: The Board reviewed a noise complaint regarding the Stratton Mountain Resort's Gather Festival from the prior weekend.

SoVTA Town Forest & Rec Area Trails: Steve Petrik from SoVTA provided updates on ACT 250 permitting, fundraising and advised that there will be trail work going on in the Rec Area July 1-Aug 15. A kiosk for maps of the trails will be added to the Rec area in the future as well.

Due to the ongoing legal matters with the Town Forest, the Board discussed maintaining the existing trails but not constructing any new trails in the Town Forest at this time. Al Dupell asked for a vote, Chris Liller made a motion, Greg Marcucci seconded and all concurred with the matter. Steve Petrik then left the meeting.

Road Crew Updates: Chris Liller, Road Foreman, reported that there continues to be an issue with Salt Supply according to his sources. The Board approved ordering next season's salt supply early as Chris was able to negotiate this winter's price until May 1 as the price is predicted to increase. The Road Crew continues to do tree work clean up and monitor the dirt roads currently closed for mud season in anticipation of a possible reopening later this week after the rain and warm up. Crack sealing is scheduled for summer of 2026.

A reduction to the speed limit in the Stratton Mountain Resort village and Mountain Rd toward Sun Bowl and corresponding signage has been requested. Chris Liller and Al Dupell met with representatives of the Resort and a traffic study will be done closer to the Memorial Day weekend to get a more accurate picture of traffic flow and speed.

Logging is done at Grout Pond. The no camping sign will go back up at Daniel Webster Monument. Viking is on schedule for next year as is the grater.

Local Emergency Management Plan: Chris Liller made a motion to re-adopt the Local Emergency Management Plan with no changes, Greg Marcucci seconded, all concurred.

Town Hall & Rec Requests: The Board approved the following requests, Wardsboro Fire & Rescue annual Turkey Supper for the week of November 10-14, 2026, Bedortha 5/23/2026, Flanagan 1/16/2027, 2/13/2027. Flanagan's 12/5/2026 request was denied as this is the date the

Board would like to host the annual Town Holiday party and a date of 12/12/2026 was counter offered.

Minutes: Boomer Walker made a motion to approve the March 23,2026 meeting minutes, Greg Marcucci seconded and all concurred.

Fleet Permits: Fleet Permits for Consolidated Construction, QXO and Fuller Sand and Gravel were considered. Al Dupell asked for a motion to approve all Chris Liller so moved, Boomer Walker seconded, and all concurred.

Act 181: The Board discussed Act 181 and Beth Liller added that Stratton's current draft map has the town in Tier 2 and Tier 3. The Board unanimously agreed that they are not in favor of Act 181 and will draft a letter in opposition.

Adjourn: Al Dupell asked for a motion to adjourn, Boomer Walker so moved, Greg Marcucci seconded, all concurred and the meeting adjourned at 8:53 pm.
