

Ready, set, enroll! What you'll need to enroll in a 2018 health insurance plan.

Open enrollment is Nov. 1 – Dec. 15, 2017

Here's what you'll need to enroll:



Marketplace account information

If you don't have an account yet, create one at healthcare.gov. Keep this info in a safe place – you'll need it when you re-enroll next year:

- Username
- Password



Personal information

For every member of your household who is enrolling:

- A social security card or permanent resident card
- W-2 tax form or proof of income
- Employer address and phone number



Current health information

- List of doctors
 - List the doctors and other health care providers you and your family may need to see in the coming year to make sure they're covered by the plan you choose
- List of medicines
 - List all the medicines you and your family may take in the coming year to make sure they're covered by the plan you choose

Don't wait to enroll!

- Most people can only sign up during open enrollment
- The healthcare.gov website is sometimes taken down for repairs. If it isn't working, try again a few hours later.

You can apply for Medicaid or CHIP (Medicaid for children) anytime, all year.
