Truth about the Gift of Life The blessing of life and the blessing of children

I. God almighty is the giver of life.

A. David the King and prophet declared life starts at conception.

Psalm 139:13–16 — "¹³ For You **formed** my inward parts; You **wove me** in my mother's womb. ¹⁴ I will give thanks to You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Wonderful are Your works, And my soul knows it very well."

- 1. When God starts *forming* and *weaving* is the moment life begins. (that's called conception)
- 2. When God started to weave, a person comes into being-*"you wove me."*

B. Three ways God is involved the activity of the womb.

Psalm 139:15 My frame was not hidden from You, When I was made in secret, And skillfully wrought in the depths of the earth; ¹⁶ Your eyes have seen my unformed substance; And in Your book were all written The days that were ordained for me, When as yet there was not one of them."

- 1. God is observing our formation v15.
- 2. God is employing divine skills to make us -v15b.
- 3. God is ordaining the length of our life -v16.
- C. Conclusion: Who is man to terminate life after conception?
 - 1. The termination of human life at any stage of development is homicide or infanticide.
- II. Children are a gift from the Lord, they are NOT a right.

Psalm 127:3–5 — "³ Behold, children are a gift of the Lord, The fruit of the womb is a reward. ⁴ Like arrows in the hand of a warrior, So are the children of one's youth. ⁵ How blessed is the man whose quiver is full of them; They will not be ashamed When they speak with their enemies in the gate."

- **A.** *"Gift"* comes from the Hebrew word *Nachalah* which is mostly translated as *"inheritance"*.
 - 1. And "*inheritance*" by nature is a gift to son's and daughters.
 - 2. Inheritances are not a right as noted in **Proverbs 11:29**—"*He* who troubles his own house will inherit wind, ..."
- B. "reward" is the second description of children.
 - 1. The meaning has to do with the reaping for all the work and travail that was endure.
- III. Children can also be a delayed gift from the Lord.
 - **A. Children can come after a temporary time of infertility.** (the scripture calls it bareness).
 - **1.** Many in the time of the Patriarchs saw bareness as being cursed for being somehow morally deficient.
 - B. Great men of God have come forth from parents who were first infertile: Sarah (Isaac), Rebekah (Jacob), Rachel (Joseph), Samson's mother, Hannah (Samuel), Elizabeth (John the Baptist).
 - **C. Application:** While children are delayed, we can still be steadfast, immoveable, abounding even more in the work of the Lord.

IV. The blessing of children can be greatly enhanced.

A. The fear of the Lord greatly increases the blessing.

Psalm 128:1–4 — "¹ How blessed is everyone who fears the Lord, Who walks in His ways. ... ³ Your wife shall be like a fruitful vine Within your house, Your children like olive plants Around your table. ⁴ Behold, for thus shall the man be blessed Who fears the Lord."

B. Obeying God creates a environment for children to flourish.

C. Spiritual compromise hurts yourself and your family.
