**CITY CLEANUP:** From 3/31/25 to 5/12/2025. The City will pick up branches periodically, as their schedule allows. Only, IF PLACED ON THE ROAD BY THE CURB (no garbage or weeds). Please cut the branches small enough to be handled by the city employees. Remove inoperable and unlicensed vehicles/trailers from the street.

**SECONDARY WATER:** Weather permitting, will be turned on April 14<sup>th</sup>, 2025.
