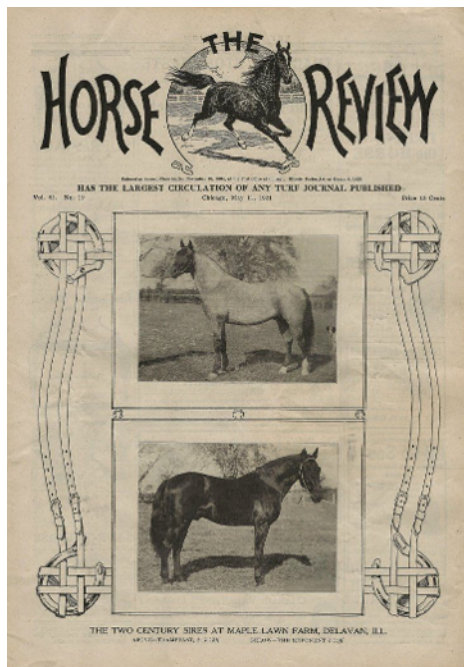

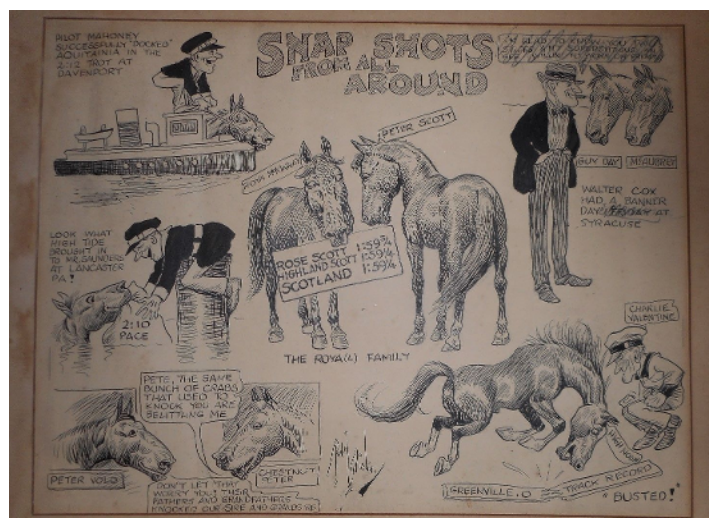

Last month we were thrilled to acquire this original artwork drawn by Robert L. Dickey in 1930 for *The Horse Review*!

It's significant to the location of our VCMEC Hobby House & Museum not only for artist Dickey (a native of nearby Marshall, Mich., who went on to fame for his artwork of horses and dogs for *The Saturday Evening Post* and *Life*), but also for the stallions that Peter Volo mentions to Chestnut Peter at lower left.

Horse Review readers in 1930 would know right away, but for those of us on this side of history, their sire Peter The Great hailed from Kalamazoo, the town next door, and became a pivotal stallion in the Standardbred breed. And most significantly of all to us at VCMEC is that their grandsire was Pilot Medium, whose meteoric rise from crippled colt to top trotting sire made him a star attraction right here in Battle Creek in the 1890s!

Gallant grey Pilot Medium passed away prematurely in 1896. The future home of VCMEC was built four years later, just a few minutes' walk from what had been his lavish stable. His death ended Battle Creek's trotting boom, and time flowed on, and on, and on. Once it flows on a little further, VCMEC plans to remember Pilot Medium in a special way that's in the works. Stay tuned!





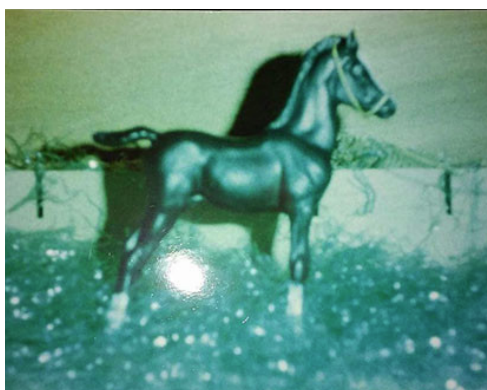

Beth Peart writes, "I actually showed him live last weekend. Times have changed.

"He's made from a Breyer El Pastor and is brush-painted in oils. His rosettes and tail are rayon fiber. He has custom shoes forged from solder wire. What I was and am really proud of is that he has the appearance of impulsion and was so well-balanced he could stand on two feet prior to

being mounted on his base.

"He did really well in live shows from his creation until the early '80s and at big events like Eastern Regional Congress and Congress in Chicago. I got out of the hobby in 1986. A lot happened over the years and he languished, forgotten for a while, broken in a box in my basement, until I started restoring him this summer. It didn't take much, but he had broken off at the fetlocks, so that needed fixing.

"Regarding his name, I think that there was once, and perhaps is a line of Hackneys by the name Birchwood. Geisha Boy was a reference to the 1958 Jerry Lewis film. I have NO idea, other than I liked the sound of it. So, I co-opted a real Hackney line name and inserted the movie title....Okay - I kind of lied about the last part. Fact is IMO he was a 'pretty boy' and 'Geisha Boy' is a now almost defunct slang for a really effeminate man, kind of along the line of 'lady-boy' today. I was a little precocious. AHM.

"I'm delighted he's had this recognition!"

I didn't have a computer at that time and went to the Internet cafe to bid on her, but I got outbid immediately every time and the auction would end a couple of days later in the very middle of the night, when no Internet cafe was open.

"So my friend Regine offered me help. We put on our alarm clocks in the middle of that night, I think it was 4 a.m. and I called her on the phone, under my bed blanket so it wasn't too loud, LOL! We drank some coffee and waited for the auction to end. The horse already had an incredible price. I had sold some of my best horses the days before to raise money, so we could bid really high in the end, and got her!! This were one of my most exciting and one of the first eBay experiences, too.

"It was a bit crazy, but I never have regretted anything, she still is my holy grail and ideal idea of a custom Quarter Horse. She looks so much like a foundation QH to me. I simply LOVE her!! I was able to get a cute working saddle with hoof pick tucked on done by Carol later, that is her saddle now.

"So this is my story about Dakota. She often accompanies me on photo tours, too."

"He was owned by the great hobby icon, Marney J. Walerius. When she passed on in 1992, Slew was part of her estate sale. But maybe due to his filler lifting, he was unsold, and lumped into a box of unloved customs that was wisely salvaged by Cheryl Monroe.

"I ended up buying him from Cheryl, and he's been here ever since. His show career hasn't been what I'd like, but I haven't shown him that much, considering.

"But he is valued as a piece of hobby history and a reminder of Marney."

"Then several years ago, GW popped up for sale again on MH\$P, this time back in the USA, but still priced higher than I could afford. I kept returning to the ad to moon over her until it disappeared. And then about a year ago, she was for sale again, this time at a price I could afford, so I jumped at the chance to buy her.

"She is holding up remarkably well given how extensively she's customized. Her hair did need a little TLC--just some very gentle brushing to unclump it--but otherwise, she's as lovely as ever.

"I'm sure she's a live show champ many times over, but I'm looking forward to being able to show her myself soon, too."

"Lot #9 NUCLEAR WINTER
Dapple grey Shire mare. Extensively remade and resculpted, this mare is a true gem for any collection. I knew from the moment that I started her that this would be a special horse and she is! There isn't a square inch of her body that hasn't been reworked, remuscled, remodelled, or rebuilt. Her color is utterly lovely, right down to her lovely white feathers. She is trotting, with head and neck tucked (somewhere under there lurks what is left of a Clydesdale Mare, so as to give you an idea of her scale), with old rose and purple ribbons and braiding, white flowers as decorations. She has fitted metal shoes, and complete and meticulously applied feathering on her feet donated by my West Highland Terriers. Chinese mohair mane and tail. She is the first offspring of my renowned Shire stallion, Massive Retaliation, offered for sale. I would be keeping

her if I showed more, she is probably the most stunning and beautiful draft horse that I've done to date. Offered sadly for sale, starting bid: \$650'

"I bought RM Nuclear Winter off eBay at least 10 years ago, maybe a few more. I paid less than what Julie originally asked for her. This was well before the market for vintage customs had taken off--I can't imagine what sort of price NW would fetch now. (Needless to say, she's part of my black hole collection now, so we'll never know.) :) I had admired Julie's work for many years, so I was really delighted to finally have a piece by her.

"From what I've been told, someone added the two disks under NW's feet to make her stand more stably at some point. Apparently, she stood balanced on just her hooves when newly made.

"I don't get the opportunity to show her a lot because I don't get to many shows, but whenever I do, she always does very well, even in open competition against newer horses. Quite a testament to Julie's talent!"

Marie Phillips writes, "I originally did him as a custom for a friend around 1990 or so, and he showed as an Appaloosa for a long time. He was a CM'd Breyer Adios named TS Fancy Pants I created around 1991 or so. Somewhere I have pix of him in that identity but it might take me years to find it, LOL.

"Then his owner got out of showing and gave the model back to me in 1993. I touched up his paint and hair job, did some work on his legs, added feathering and decided to show him as a Pinzgauer-Noriker, and because I was reading the series that started with the book called 'The Dragon and the George,' I renamed TS Dragon Knight after the main character.

"Since his debut in 1993 he's done very well, earning multi Championships in photo showing, and in the couple of times in 1998-2000 I took him live showing he won ribbons. 2nd place if I recall correctly. In 2004 I touched up his paint again, a slight change to his spot coloring, so it appeared more realistic.

"He still shows very well with the new photos I took of him over the years. He is one model I would never sell.

"He appears in Volume 2 of 'The Secret Life of Model Horses,' which is not yet in print, but is in the works.

"Volume One is available for anyone who remembers my writing those tales for the 'Flying Hooves Express.' I edited and reworked all those tales and

finally published them, and plan to publish the 2nd volume in the next year or so if all goes well."

A Few Notes from Steward Sparky C.

We knew the VCMEC Online World Championships were going to be epic--but stewarding has been an adventure in itself!

To help maintain consistency throughout this six-leg series, we decided to overhaul the Workmanship division classlist and move horses to their proper new classes. We split several categories by scale, and since some entrants weren't sure whether their horses' hair manes were natural fiber or synthetic, we retooled those classes to be simply hair and non-hair.

Also for the sake of consistency, we worked out a system to deter-

mine whether a remade model is a Simple, Major, or Extreme CM. It ain't scientific, but, we divide the horse into five portions. The first portion is the head/neck. The rest of the body is divided into quarters for the other four portions, each with one leg.

If a horse was remade in just one portion, 1/5 or 20% of the horse is affected, so that's less than 25%, so is a "Simple" remake. Two or three remade portions is less than 75%, so is a "Major" remake. Four or more remade portions is more than 75% so is an "Extreme" remake.

If a horse has a head transplant, or an opened, detailed mouth (not just a sawed-open slit), or distinctive new physical attributes sculpted onto the original body, an additional "portion" is counted to reflect the increased level of customization. Added genitalia and resculpted hooves are partial portions, depending on what other customization was done. (For example, a repainted and haired horse with added genitalia would be a "Simple" remake. A horse remade in one portion, plus added genitalia, would still be a "Simple" remake.)

Yep, it's an adventure!

Legs of the 2016-17 VCMEC Online World Championship series are held quarterly. There are five left: in 2016 starting on Dec. 1 (its entry deadline is Nov. 29 midnight Eastern Standard Time), and in 2017 starting on March 1, June 1, Sept. 1, and Dec. 1. The show results will be published right here in **VCMEC Model Horse Re-View**, the free online publication of the Vintage Custom Model Equine Center.

Due to the nature of this competition, new entrants will only be accepted until February 15, 2017, so don't miss out!
