

**AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO**  
**Ordinance O-2014-03**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ANNEXATION OF LOTS 18 AND 19 OF  
MACFARLAND SUBDIVISION, OWNED BY AMELIA VILLAGE AND DIRECTING  
THE VILLAGE SOLICITOR TO FILE A PETITION WITH THE CLERMONT  
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**

**WHEREAS**, Amelia Village has an interest in annexing land that is owned by the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village currently owns Lots 18 and 19 of MacFarland Subdivision that are located in Batavia Township and which the Village desires to annex; and

**WHEREAS**, the land that is proposed to be annexed is adjacent and contiguous to Amelia Village and further described in the attached "Exhibit A" and depicted in the attached "Exhibit B"; and

**WHEREAS**, the municipal annexation procedure must be initiated by petition to the Clermont County Board of Commissioners pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 709.14 through 709.16; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, that:

**SECTION I.** Council considers it necessary to annex the subject property into Amelia Village.

**SECTION II.** The Village Solicitor is hereby directed to petition the Clermont County Commissioners for annexation of Lots 18 and 19 of MacFarland Subdivision, located in Batavia Township, Clermont County, Ohio in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Sections 709.14 through 709.16, and to serve as Amelia Village's agent in this annexation proceeding.

**SECTION III.** Village Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION IV.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in full from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
