Church Internal Controls require a regular schedule of reporting and accountability in five (5) key areas of ministry finances. Each area of reporting provides essential information needed to explain the details of a specific part of the church's finances. These reports are...

- 1. Balance Sheet
- 2. Revenue & Expenditure Report
- 3. Church Budget Report
- 4. Vendors List
- 5. Accounts Payables Report

Churches desiring to have strong internal controls must have a regimented presented and review of the above reports that is frequent enough to discourage and avoid the misuse and misappropriation of funds.

Part 3 of Church Finance Internal Controls is a tutorial for ministry leaders who have the need to understand and learn about church finances. EVERY MINISTRY LEADER (Pastors, Deacons, Deaconesses, Trustees, Ministers, etc.) and EVERY MEMBER is invited to attend this Ministry Training Track session as together, we help bring your church, ministry, and congregation into your *Season of Change*.
