DESCRIPTION: This iconic Kodiak Magnum is a great looking and performing re-curve. Golden Rosewood and Bubinga riser. Comfortable grip. Factory installed stabilizer bushing. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. The only flaw with this bow are the filled screw holes (2 on the side of the riser, and 2 on the face—see pics on last page) . No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in very good shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed. Then taken to the range and test shot. Comes with a new Bear style rug rest and side plate, and a new string.
