

Once we figured out Laney's secret, the rest of us started having better luck. For once, no one was skunked and we all learned why Randy will catch and release from now on. The surf Gods rolled in a big wave a took back the Perch Randy hand put in his bucket, oh well they really weren't that big anyway. As the high tide peaked we left the fish biting, I got my 7<sup>th</sup> and last perch on my last cast, But Laney took top honors with eleven. Way to go Laney. ### Accurate/Royal Polaris 18 day/fly home trip By Gary Gillingham

I just got back from the Accurate/Royal Polaris 18 day/fly home trip.

We left Feb 7th and the boat returned Feb 25.

It had a fly home option and all but 2 passengers flew home from Cabo on Feb 22.

I was the Accurate rep for this trip and brought 40 loaner outfits for people to use.

I also gave away about 60 wahoo jigs, two reels and four rods and shirts, pliers and other misc. goodies.

Spent four day traveling to Hurricane Banks and spent a total of 1 1/2 fishing days there. The bank was absolutely dead, even fishing live flying fish under the kite produced only a few smaller fish. One angler did hook a aprox 800lb Black Marlin that jumped once and then spooled the angler and a friend of mine hooked another unstoppable monster of the Bank.

I did get lucky and landed a 208 YFT on my Accurate ATD 30 fly lining a sardine at the bank.

Soon as I landed that fish we pulled anchor and headed to the Clarion Island buffer zone.

Made the run to Clarion Island and checked into the camp. (went very smooth).

Spent the next 6 days there and we caught a lot of fish. The grade of fish was small with most being the 40 to 80 LB stuff. There was a few exceptions as I caught a 202 LB. YFT on the kite using my Accurate ATD 80 (The Tractor) and my friend Roger caught a 245 YFT on bait and another over 200 on bait. We also had some fish in the 100 to 170 LB. range.

Wahoo fishing was good with a mix with size ranging from 15 to 72 lb.!


Lot's of Humpback whales, Manta rays, Frigate and Booby birds to watch.

Sharks were few and only a few fish got bit.

Over all a great trip with the size of fish being on the small side.

One of the best group of anglers I have fished with and some had been going on this trip for the last 12 years.
