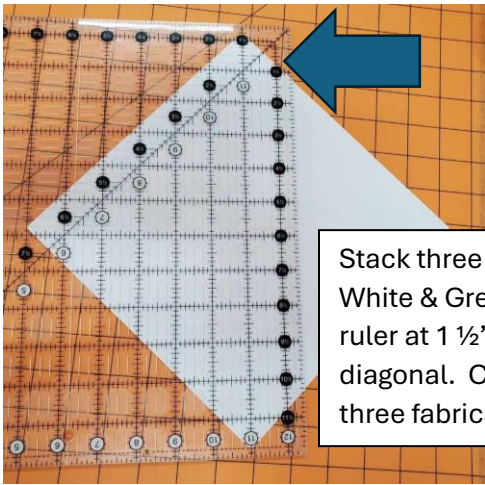
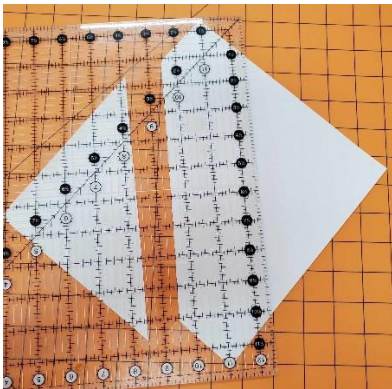


Pam's Lottery Blocks for November

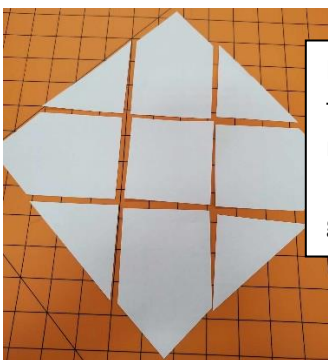
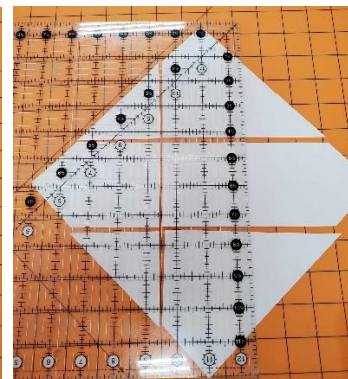
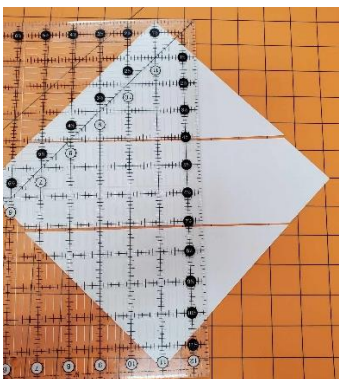
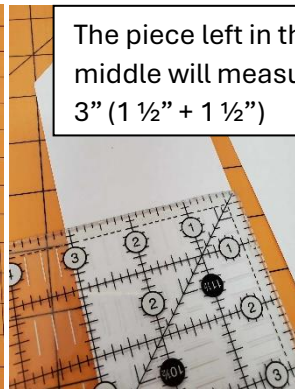


Stack three 9" fabrics- Red, White & Green. Align your ruler at 1 1/2" from diagonal to diagonal. Cut through all three fabrics

*If you have a rotating mat, this would be a great time to use it! Twist your fabrics around and Align your ruler again at 1 1/2" from the diagonal.



The piece left in the middle will measure 3" (1 1/2" + 1 1/2")



Realign your fabric stacks to form the square again. You'll repeat the same alignment at 1 1/2" from the center diagonal going both sides of the center.



Reshuffle your stacks so that each block will have Red, White & Green



Sew together the corners, center, and corners. **Important! Align by the center of the block, the triangles will NOT match on the outside edges!



Sew together the three diagonal sets to form the block! Trim the block to 7 1/2"

If you are unsure about trimming the blocks, turn them in untrimmed
