Mr. Allaire explains his interpretation of "part-time" and RVA certification. Councilwoman Nissula directs the discussion to Attorney Matt Johnson. Mr. Johnson discussion Leisure Time CUP, with the land use to be "temporary." Mr. Johnson states the need to further research whether or not the use at Leisure Time is exceeding the use that it is permitted under either the City Ordinances and/or land use ordinances. Mr. Johnson needs to do further research. Further discussion by Johnson of the fact that the transmission from temporary housing to more permanent style housing. At some point the City might have a zone that is completely out of compliance with the intent of that Zone and the possible need of the City to rezone or revision of the CUP. Design is outside of the City's prevue and really is an HOA's type issue and that is not City's part to get into. Mr. Johnson believes the issue of whether or not these constitute RVs or crossing the line into a modular home begins to threaten the land use that the City set up. This is a wide spread issue. Discussion of moratorium and need to revisit this issue. Discussion as to the taxing of these units. Mr. Allaire gives his interpretation of the taxing of these units. Mr. White voices his interpretation. Mayor inquires has the City need to move forward. Mr. Johnson explains the need for clarification, CUP and/or zoning.
