To Whom It May Concern:

When choosing furniture for school, you should consider the following guidelines:

- Safety: The furniture should be sturdy and stable, it should have rounded edges and corners, and comply with fire safety regulations
 - Fire Rating- Please check for proper fire rating when purchasing furniture to be used at school. All
 proposed furniture must meet flame resistance and cleanability standards. Durability: The materials
 used and how they will be affected by the school's conditions.
- Durability: The furniture should be sturdy and capable of withstanding frequent use.
 - o Will it clean/disinfect easily and withstand daily, repetitive use?
 - Will it hold up against zippers, buttons, shoes, and backpacks?
 - Weight capacity: Whether the furniture can safely support the weight of students.
- Comfort: The furniture should be ergonomic and support proper posture.
- Purpose: The furniture should be suitable for the age and needs of the students.
- Flexibility: The furniture should be easy to reconfigure and adjustable for height as necessary.
- Certifications: The furniture can be reviewed for certifications like GREENGUARD or BIFMA, which indicate that it meets certain standards.
- Manufacturer: The manufacturer should have a proven testing process and good customer service.

All furniture purchases must be approved by your Principal and Operations Director; please send proposed furniture specifications before ordering. Any used furniture that you would like to bring in must go through the same process.
