

# Ordinance No 177

Sec Ordinance appropriating certain monies

Sec 1

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Lowell that the sum of Two Hundred and eleven ~~and~~ <sup>and</sup> 35/100 Dollars

is hereby appropriated out of the <sup>any monies not otherwise appropriated in</sup> General Fund of the City Treasury for the payment of the bills allowed Nov 5 1896 a list of which is found on page 16 of the Journal of the proceedings of the Council of said date

Sec 2

that the sum of Seventy Five Dollars is hereby appropriated out of any monies not otherwise appropriated in the Water Works Funds of the City Treasury for the payment of the bills allowed Nov 5 1896 a list of which is found on page 17 of the Journal of the <sup>the Council</sup> proceedings of said date

Sec 3

that the sum of <sup>Dollars and</sup> Sixty two cents is hereby appropriated ~~of~~ <sup>in</sup> the ~~City~~ <sup>City</sup> Treasury for the payment of the bills allowed Nov 5 1896 a list of which is found on

Sec 4<sup>th</sup> That the Mayor and <sup>clerk</sup> be and are hereby authorized and directed to draw warrants on the city treasurer for the payment of the bills allowed <sup>and</sup> sections 1 - 2 and 3 of this Ordinance

Sec 5 This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor
