### About the County

Santa Cruz County is located on California's Central Coast, 65 miles south of San Francisco and 35 miles north of Monterey. Situated on the northern side of Monterey Bay and hugged by redwood forested mountains, Santa Cruz County has 29 miles of beaches and an extraordinary number of state parks and beaches – 14 in all – and each offers a unique experience for visitors. The nearest airport is in San Jose, 30 miles northeast of Santa Cruz.

As of the 2020 census, the population was 270,861. Santa Cruz County comprises of 4 incorporated cities: Capitola, Santa Cruz, Scotts Valley and Watsonville.
