In reference to Carol's email and two attached letters regarding paving sent to Messrs. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] (see below), I discussed the contents of these letters sent to D1 constituents with Supervisor Miller. Supervisor Miller asked me to provide the following response to you, as well as Messrs. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] who are copied on this email:

1. It appears the originator and contents of these letters (authorship unknown as the two letters attached were sent to us by Carol and do not have signatures; on the signatory line there is only the reference to "Pima County Department of Transportation"), may be attempting to influence the outcome of an election; and
2. Attached is a copy of Attorney General Mark Brnovich's July 30, 2015 opinion (No. 115-002 AMENDED (R15-002)) re: Use of Public Funds to Influence the Outcomes of Elections. The AG's opinion provides guidance on the limitations imposed by A.R.S. Sec 11-410 on the use of county resources to influence an election.
