


# SFYC

Destination: Naples Sailing and Yacht Club

Navigation:

Latitude 20' 08.251"N

Longitude 081' 47.346"W

- Proceed South along the coast from the Sanibel Bridge approximately 27 NM to Gordon Pass/Naples Inlet.
- Pick up day marker Green "1" and Red Flashing "2" and proceed up Naples Harbor towards Green day marker "39". As you approach Red 40 the Naples Sailing and Yacht Club is at 12 O'Clock and approximately 500' ahead.

Upon Arrival:

- Contact the Harbormaster on Channel 16 prior to entering the dock area for arrival and slip confirmation.
- Marilyn and Francisco from the Yacht Club and your cruise leaders will be there to meet you. Your dock tips will already have been paid.
- A signature drink will be provided by your host on arrival.
- If you are driving down to join us the address is Naples Sailing & Yacht Club 896 River Point Drive Naples, FL 34102

General Information:

- The Yacht Club does NOT take credit cards; all payments will have to be by cash or check.
- Rates are \$2.50/ft, 50 Amp is \$20/night and 30 Amp is \$10/night

- Fuel is available at American Marine 1 mile away. 20 cents/Gal discount for Boat US and 5 cents/Gal for Active Captain members.
- The Club has very nice restrooms and showers available for us. Bring towels.
- Free WiFi and Cable Available
- The Bar/Restaurant on the premises is closed on Monday and will only be open for lunch on Tuesday.
- Most of our gatherings will be on the dock or at the pool area so you may want to bring along a light jacket depending on the weather.

#### Transportation:

- 4 Loaner bikes are available and additional bikes can be rented.
- Naples Bay water shuttle is available for trips to several local establishments. More at <http://naplesbaywatershuttle.com/>

#### Local Food:

- Several restaurants are very close and offer a full variety of local fare, including Tin City, Bonefish Grill, Wharf Restaurant, The Dock, Kelly's Fish House and The Boathouse restaurant. You can walk to some and the water shuttle services all of them.

#### Other Thoughts:

- They have a very nice pool area so bring your suits if you would like to swim.
- You may want to bring folding or bag chairs for our dockside gatherings

## PET ETIQUETTE

1. When on a cruise, most marina's have rules, please follow them.
  2. State of Florida prohibits pets on pool decks and in pools for sanitary reasons.
  3. Please use designated waste areas and pick up all waste and dispose of it properly.
  4. At any docktails, meals, parties, etc. please do not allow your pet by the food, hot grills, or on tables and chairs.
  5. Keep the noise level of your pet to a minimum.
  6. It is your responsibility to keep your dog on a leash and under control, please do so Do not tie them to a tree and leave.
  7. Certain individuals have many good reasons for not wanting to interact with our pets. Please respect their wishes.
  8. Many individuals do not understand the companionship owners have with their pets. Don't automatically think they are welcome at every social event.
  9. A service dog, as defined by the Americans With Disabilities Act as "any guide dog, signal dog, or other animal individually trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability" has access to anywhere their handler goes.
- We hope these rules will make for a pleasant cruise for pet owners, cruisers and our loved pets.
