Jim Robinson (Gucci) is an artist from Troy, NY exhibiting an eclectic range of graphics, drawings and paintings (and prints of) including documentary/military works, local portraits, landscapes, architectural art, Romantic works, Biblical works, and logo and book cover designs.

He published his first works at 16 (1983) for Precision Graphics, Inc. in Schenectady, NY, and a lifelong collection of works can be found on JRartworks.org. His most extensive work is the 900+ sq. ft. mural at LoPorto's Restaurant in Troy, NY (circa 2000-2010).

Jim holds a BS in Visual Art Education with an emphasis in graphic design and illustration from SUNY New Paltz. He has taught Art at all grade levels, and he is currently teaching non-credit Drawing at the Glen Eddy Retirement Center and Schenectady County Community College. He is also doing graphic design work for the American-Italian Museum in Albany, NY.
