Time to stroll around the Old Town, then ride the Funicular up the hill and visit the red-walled Castle where the Great Vat, a 58,000 –gallon 18th-century wine cask, attracts particular attention. Then on to Rudesheim on the Rhine.

September 30- Rudesheim and the Rhine

Breakfast this morning. Rudesheim on the Rhine we will visit Siegfried's Music Cabinet Museum. This is the first museum collection of automated musical instruments in Germany and holds an impressive collection. Followed by our Farewell Dinner on the Rhine.
