Meeting of the DeKalb County Commission

Presiding Commissioner, Harold Allison, West District Commissioner Kyle White, East District Commissioner, Garry McFee and County Clerk, Melissa Meek.

Presiding Commissioner, Harold Allison, led all in attendance in prayer with all reciting the Pledge of Allegiance. Office holders and employees attended the prayer and pledge this Monday morning.

The Commission welcomes any and all to the openings of their Commission meetings.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to approve the agenda with East District Commissioner, Garry McFee made the second. Motion carried. East District Commissioner, Garry McFee made the motion to approve the minutes from the October 9th meeting with West District Commissioner, Kyle White making the second. Motion carried.

The Commission again discussed drainage issues in the County as well as issues with patrons damming up ditches. Patrons will have to get their attorney involved to get this situation resolved.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek presented the sales tax distribution notice.

The reading of the Liberty Road closure was done and noted that said road will close in January.

Chief Deputy Kasey Keesaman presented paperwork that needed to be renewed for the LESO program (Government Surplus). A patron had contacted him concerning a tube that was smashed. The Commission advised that said patron needed to contact the township in which this happened.

Sheriff Andy Clark discussed with the Commission the need to retain good officers and that is an ongoing problem in most County's. The Commission approved for Andy to order 2 new vehicles for his office from the bids he had retained. The vehicles will need to be ordered now in order to have them by February 1. Andy also discussed the County paying a deputy while they go thru the academy with the deputy reimbursing the County he doesn't stay employed here the length of time requested. This has been done in the road & bridge department and has worked out well.

The Purple Heart presentation will be held at 13:30 on the 22nd at the Courthouse. The Commission asks all patrons to attend and if you know of any Purple Heart Recipients that you invite them as well as all Veteran's.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek discussed the issues with the roof and the cornerstone on top of the building. The roof still has warranty but the tuck pointing that was done does not. Both vendors have been notified of the need to get this repaired immediately. Water was in different parts of the building with our last big rains.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White the motion to adjourn with East District Commissioner, Garry McFee making the second. Motion carried.
