Notes: Century won its third title in the last four years...The WDA had the top 6 teams (Century, Williston, Dickinson, Jamestown, Bismarck High, Legacy)...A WDA has won the state team title every year since 2004...Dickinson's Brady Yoder won the individual title in a time of 15:20...Yoder is the first Dickinson runner to win the title since Tim Wheeler (1977)...Fifteen WDA runners earn all-state honors led by Century which had five...Six WDA teams had at least one all-state runner...Ten WDA teams participated...There were 183 runners...Williston's Micade Shumway was named state senior athlete of the year...Williston coach Shane Wahlstrom was named state coach of the year...Minot hosted the meet for the first time since 2014
