**Eligible Dogs:** These trials are open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternate Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Dogs should be physically sound.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word “dog” is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog’s physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

**Please sign-up to work at the trial! (An online volunteers list will be available in advance.)**

It takes a lot of people to run an agility trial. The Club would appreciate your help in making sure the trial is a success and hopes that everyone will volunteer for **at least** 1-2 positions each day! Thank you for your help!

**Show Site & Hours:** Trials will be conducted in One Ring 100'X90' indoor on dirt.

**Thursday:** Trial set-up begins at 12:00 PM and end at 7:00 PM.

Personal set-up will not begin until after all trial set-up is complete!

**Friday, Saturday, & Sunday:** Trial site hours are 8:00 AM to 30 minutes after the last dog runs.

**Obstacles:** Obstacles will conform to current requirements of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

### Course Walk Through & Warm Up Information

Handlers in all classes will be permitted to walk the course without a dog, during a walk-through prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only.

A warmup area consisting of a single regulation agility jump will be provided. "No agility obstacle training is allowed on the show grounds except for the use of the warm-up jump." (Chapter 4, Section 15 of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials) The "grounds" include the entire Sirius Ranch facility, parking lots, RV/motor home parking area, etc.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to check in with the gate steward and be at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The Judge is not obligated to wait for any exhibitor.

### Classes Offered

**Standard Classes:** Novice A & B, Open, Excellent, Masters, Premier, Novice Preferred, Open Preferred, Excellent Preferred, Masters Preferred, Premier Preferred

**Jumpers with Weaves:** Novice A & B, Open, Excellent, Masters, Premier, Novice Preferred, Open Preferred, Excellent Preferred, Masters Preferred, Premier Preferred

**Time to Beat:** Regular and Preferred

**FAST Classes:** Novice A & B, Open, Excellent & Masters, Novice Preferred, Open Preferred, Excellent & Masters Preferred

**Classes:** It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter the dog in the correct class. The trial secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups & as provided for in Chapter 1 Section 21 of the Agility Trial Regulations) after the closing date of the trial. Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete

description and eligibility to enter into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible to enter into the correct class(es) and height divisions. Dogs running in a lower or higher height division than they are eligible will be eliminated.

### **Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020**

#### **Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend**

- Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title.
- The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

#### **Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day**

- Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

**Note -** A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

### **Effective July 1, 2024 Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)**

For Exhibition Only will be offered by OTCC in all classes!

- FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment.
- **FEO is 45 seconds for all classes except FAST which remains the same.**
- Participation in FEO is non-qualifying. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class.
- FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If the dog in an ineligible jump height, for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handler's hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

### **Fix and Go On (FNG) As of January 1, 2020**

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

**Jump Height Cards:** All dogs entered **MUST** be measured by the judge before their **first** run except those with AKC jump height cards. This judge is a VMO. **It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running if necessary.** If your dog is measured into a taller jump height class, he must be moved up into it at the trial. **If your dog is measured down, he cannot be moved into a lower jump class. Measuring will take place at 8:15 AM, on June 12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, & 14<sup>th</sup>, 2026.** It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card at each trial to present upon request.

**Jump Height Card Process:** There is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or needs to be measured. Please mark the appropriate box, so the trial secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs to be Measured List.

**Online vs. Paper Entry Primary Limits:** During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 50%: Paper entries: 50%. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour period, OTCC reserves the right to adjust the limits.

**Maximum entries per envelope:** A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.

**Note:** Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone, fax, or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Overnight mail entries should have the “no signatures” box checked. No entries shall be made or accepted, which specifies any conditions as to acceptance. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Entries not on an AKC form (that includes the disclaimer form on the back) are not acceptable. Please make sure only AKC recognized prefixes and suffixes are used on all entries. Titles are not included in the catalogue. **Incomplete entry forms cannot be processed. All entry form information/updates must be submitted in writing prior to closing.**

**Email confirmation will be sent to those listing a legible email address.** Final entry confirmation and judging schedule will be e-mailed or sent to the entry address as soon as possible after the closing date. If you have not received confirmation at least 7 days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

**Wait List Information:** OTCC is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial’s closing date/time. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the club’s wait list. All entries, including wait list entries must be received by the Trial Secretary **prior to Friday, June 5, 2026, 8:00PM**. Any entries **withdrawn by June 5, 2026, 8:00PM** will be replaced by a wait list entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry, including bitches that come in to heat. Any wait-listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by June 5, 2026, 8:00PM will receive a full refund.

**Move-Ups:** Move up to a higher class will be allowed if received by the Trial Secretary in writing by Monday, **June 8, 2026, 8:00pm AKST**. No move-ups will be accepted after that date and time. E-mails can be sent to [aktralsecretary@gmail.com](mailto:aktralsecretary@gmail.com). Move-ups for Saturday or Sunday will be allowed if received by the trial secretary in writing **within 30 minutes** of the end of judging on the previous day at the trial site. No move-ups will be accepted after that time. Verbal changes will not be accepted.

## **Notices to Exhibitors**

This trial will be held under the AKC rules and regulations for agility trials. Exhibitors are expected to be familiar with these rules and regulations.

**FOOD:** Denise will be our food vendor. Please plan to support her.

**Trophies:** Ribbons for first, second, third, fourth place, qualifying scores, and new titles will be given. A Double Q ribbon and pin will be awarded to dogs earning a Double Q in Masters. MACH, PACH, PAX and Titling ribbons will be awarded to those earning titles at these trials.

**Token:** Each entered dog will receive one toy for the weekend.

**Exhibitors Responsibility:**

It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to take care of their dogs and to clean any area(s) soiled by their dogs. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds

**All dogs must be on leash** at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course. No flexi leads are allowed on the property at Sirius Ranch. Dogs should not be off leash while on the property or walked near the private residences on the property.

**Rules of Conduct at Sirius Ranch:**

We want Sirius Ranch to be a safe and fun facility for everyone and their dog(s). Sirius Ranch does not tolerate harassment, bullying or unsportsmanlike conduct on the property at any time. Any person violating the policy will be asked to leave or will be removed without reason or cause. Clubs and their members are asked to enforce this policy.

**Event Cancellation:** No refund of entry will be made for riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management if it is impossible to open or complete the trial. The well-being of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators is of paramount importance, and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry will be made.

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date with two exceptions. Dogs replaced by wait listed dogs will receive a full refund. With written notice, handlers with bitches who come in to heat after the closing date and before or during the trial, may receive a refund of entry fees minus \$10 (if they cannot be replaced by a waitlisted entry). Written notice can be by email and must be given to the Trial Secretary.

### **Safety, Behavior, and Liability**

The safety of all dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport and that their dogs are trained and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and children at all times. Dogs and children must not create disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior. The welfare and supervision of children is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor. Failure to follow the premium or directions of the Trial Committee may result in disciplinary action. The Club reserves the right to remove any dog for aggression or disruptive behavior and to decline or cancel any entry for cause. Any dismissal from competition, regardless of reason, will not result in a refund.

Judges will disqualify any dog that attacks a person in the ring. A judge will excuse any dog that attacks another dog in the ring or that the judge observes attacking another dog while entering or exiting the ring.

Owners and handlers enter at their own risk and assume responsibility for any damage or injury caused by themselves, their dogs, or their children. Exhibitors agree to abide by the Rules of the American Kennel Club and these regulations.

The Obedience Training Club of Chugiak, Sirius Ranch, and their members, agents, and employees assume no responsibility for loss, damage, or injury to persons, dogs, children, or property. All attendees waive any claim for damages against the Obedience Training Club of Chugiak, Inc. or its members if a vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation. No person shall have any recourse or claim against the Obedience Training Club of Chugiak, Sirius Ranch, or any event official.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete, however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
