
I saw the messages start to flood in on Twitter. I turned on the TV and saw the chaos in Washington, DC. I listened to the continuous coverage.

In order to make sure all children and teens have access to food for the entire 2020-21 school year, the US Department of Agriculture (USDA) has extended the Free Meals Program known as the Summer Food Service Program.

The program is funded by the USDA and administered by the Illinois State Board of



Education (ISBE).

Sponsors of this program are able to provide free meals to all children and teens 18 years of age and under. No family will have to worry about their child going without a healthy school meal, whether they are learning from home or at school. During this time, there is no paperwork, no registration, and no income verification required.
