

# HIGH SIERRA TEAM PLAY BLAWS

## ARTICLE I PURPOSE

The purpose of this Club is to promote Women's golf through team tournaments.

## ARTICLE II MEMBERSHIP

Membership in this Club shall consist of the existing Member Clubs. Any additional clubs must be approved by a majority vote of the Executive Committee.

## ARTICLE III GOVERNING BODY

Each member club shall appoint a Team Captain and Co-Captain. They shall be the governing body of that club. Each Member Club shall have only one vote.

## ARTICLE IV EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The Executive Committee shall consist of a President, Secretary and Treasurer. They shall serve a two-year term. They shall be elected on even years at the Fall Meeting by a majority vote of the Team Captains or their representatives. Nominations may also be made from the floor.

### SECTION I

**President:** Shall preside over the annual meetings. Shall inform the Captains of all issues concerning HSTP. In each second even numbered year, the President shall appoint a Nominating Committee Chair. The Nominating Committee Chair, along with her committee, shall develop a slate of nominees for each Executive Board position at least 30 days prior to Fall HSTP meeting. Additional nominations may be made from the floor.

**Secretary:** Shall compile and keep a roster of each Member Club's Team Captain and Co-Captain. Shall record the minutes of the meetings. Shall distribute correspondence as necessary.

**Treasurer:** Shall collect, deposit and disperse all funds. Shall present reports at the meetings.

## ARTICLE V MEETINGS

There shall be a Spring and Fall meeting each year. A majority of the Team Captains or their representatives present shall be a quorum.

## ARTICLE VI DUES

Each club shall pay annual membership dues. The dues will be set at each Fall meeting and will be due by March 1<sup>st</sup>.

## ARTICLE VII AMENDMENTS

These bylaws may be amended at the annual meeting by a majority vote of the Team Captains, provided that written or electronic notice has been given thirty (30) days prior to the meeting.

## ARTICLE VII PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY

The rules contained in the most current edition of "Robert's Rules of Order-Newly Revised" shall govern the Club in all cases in which it is not inconsistent with the Bylaws and any special rules of order the Club may adopt.
