March 26th, 2018

I. Call to order

IV. Treasures Report

The cash balance on November 29, 2017 was \$26,199.21.

Deposits made in the months of December, January, February, and March totaled \$824.34 (largest deposit was remaining cash in boxes).

Expenses paid in the months of December, January, February, and March totaled \$643.02 (two largest expenses--Sears and Property Tax).

Our current balance is \$26,379.45.

NOTE: Insurance was paid today: \$3048.80.

VI. New business

- a) **Incoming/Outgoing CCTC Board Members:** Trevor Harder and Marci Bergquist have stepped down, Dick Doucette to be new VP and Audrey Beisel to be new secretary.

- b) **Summer Schedule & Pricing:** New Schedule in team packets, pricing will stay the same.
- c) **Work Days:** April 21st @ 9am, weather permitting, will postpone one week if bad weather. Will then open following day.
- d) **Volunteer Sign-up:** Proposed new requirement- Teams must sign up for one workday and at least one member must show up or the team will be disqualified for the Shoot Out.
- e) **Ham Shoot:** Hams have been ordered, Pat will call other trap club to coordinate dates to have shoots on different weekends. Proceeds to go to the Morrow family.
- f) **4-H Program:** Request from Taura Purdue for use of one house on Monday nights for about 1-1 ½ hrs. to instruct and shoot. Crooked Creek Trap Club will donate the use of the house for the 4-h students.
- g) **NRA membership discussion:** Crooked Creek Trap Club will continue to stay as a 100% NRA member club, those who choose to not be an NRA member will still be able to shoot at the club on Sundays and Mondays when open to the public but will not be able to participate in League Shoot. The club is insured through the NRA, the insurance is required for the lease agreement for the land.
- h) **Potential Education Opportunity:** Discussed the possibility of offering educational class(es) for high school students. Still in the idea process.
- i) **New Scoring Idea:** Frank Sheperd brought to attention a glitch in the application of our handicap system if a team shoots with less than five shooters. He has done extensive research on this and has come up with a few resolutions to fix this glitch and make scoring fair, will be discussed at next meeting with all members. Below are the issues that were brought forward.
 - i) An individual shooter on an incomplete team gets a distance advantage in the individual "TOP GUN" competition.
 - ii) An incomplete team has an artificially lower total score which is used in determining "A" and "B" flight and shooting distance in the SHOOT OFF (bracketing placement) also giving them a distance advantage during the shoot.
