

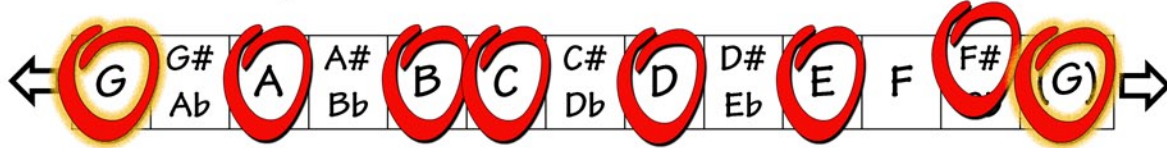

(Major chords = capitalized Roman numerals, minor chords = lower case)

Roman Numeral	Chord Name	Notes that make up each chord
I	G MAJOR	G , B , D (1, 3, 5)
ii	A minor	A , C , E (2, 4, 6)
iii	B minor	B , D , F# (3, 5, 7)
IV	C MAJOR	C , E , G (4, 6, 1)
V	D MAJOR	D , F# , A (5, 7, 2)
vi	E minor	E , G , B (6, 1, 3)
