Maintenance Items

Over the past few months, a great many projects were completed. These included: replacement of concrete sections around the Gazebo, major tree trimming behind Carlson Ridge Rd. and Court, asphalt repairs to several driveways and complete driveway replacement for 2 units, stump grinding and removal of 12 tree stumps, power washing of half the units in the complex, replacement of diverters for 5 units, repairs and painting of wood around door frames on Sussex models, and pillars and door frames painted on Filmore, Radison, and Stanwicke models.

In our last newsletter, it was reported that the Board was looking to install a street light at the entrance of our development. Unfortunately the town did not approve our proposal of adding a light to our currently existing utility pole near the entrance. We obtained an estimate to add an additional street lamp similar to those currently existing on our property, but the cost of approximately \$6000 was unacceptable. In an effort to make the entrance more visible, the underbrush and some trees were removed from the front of the property along Rt. 202 and this has greatly improved the visibility.

New Business

Ralph Manning, a handyman on our list of vendors, will be conducting inspections on all decks as there has been some rotting reported to the Board. Decks are a limited common element and the repair of such is the responsibility of the homeowner. You will be notified if such a repair is needed. Mr. Manning would be available to handle such repairs as well.

Gutter cleaning will take place after the leaves have fallen and the final fall cleanup will be done by Bruzzi.



Other Business

You have been notified recently of two vacancies on the Board. Bill O'Loughlin has served on the Board for 6 years as President and Vice President, and Alan Lachlan has served on the Board as Secretary for 8 years. Their service has been exceptional and greatly appreciated. We urge all homeowners to consider volunteering. We can not function effectively without a full five member board so please give this serious consideration.
