Welcome to Annunciation! We are pleased that you've chosen to worship here today. Everything you need to participate in the service is in this bulletin or in one of the two hymnals in the pew rack in front of you. Congregational prayers and responses are indicated by **bold, italic** type. At communion time, we invite everyone — whether you grew up in the Episcopal church or not — to receive the bread and wine at the Lord's table.

Children are invited to participate fully in the service, as well — in the prayers, in singing, in communion. The more that kids can see, the more they'll feel part of the service, and so parents are encouraged to sit wherever their children can view the action the best. We recognize that kids can't always sit still for a full service, and we're not bothered by their rustlings or outpourings of energy. If you feel like you need to step out of the service for a moment, though, know that you'll still be able to see and hear the service from the narthex (entryway) area. Age-appropriate KidsWord activity sheets, which help explain the day's scripture readings, are available on the table by the church office.

If you are visiting here for the first time, please sign our guest register before leaving and know that you are welcome to join fellow worshipers at coffee hour in the Parish Hall following the service. CAPITAL CAMPAIGN PHASE 2 - 2019

Thank you to all who have filled out your Capital Campaign pledge sheet and have let your voice be heard regarding the Parish Hall ceiling. As you heard last week, the Capital Campaign committee reviewed the ceiling project with the Vestry and the Vestry voted to move forward with the ceiling even though all the funds have not been pledged. They also requested that the Finance Committee review our funds and work with the Capital Campaign committee to identify other ways to pay off the Line Of Credit if we do not receive all the needed money through Capital Campaign pledges. We currently have \$28,000 of the \$60,000 committed. The contracts are underway and we are scheduling the work to start just after Easter Sunday. HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

Join us for our annual Annunciation Service Project with Habitat for Humanity "to build safe, affordable housing" for a family in Northern Illinois, "that comes from a desire to put God's love into action".

Based on feedback from parishioners and recommendations from Habitat for Humanity, we have selected Friday and Saturday, May 17th and 18th for Annunciation's Service Project.
