

Ordinance No 586

an Ordinance appropriating certain moneys

Sec I

That the sum of One Hundred and Ninety Three ^{and 22/100} Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the General Funds of the City Treasury to pay the Bills allowed ^{against said fund} at a regular meeting of the the Board of Commissioners held on the second day of February 1914 a list of which may be found on 126 page of the Journal of the proceedings of the Board on that date.

Sec II

That the sum of Five Hundred and Eighty Three ^{and 56/100} Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the water works funds of the City Treasury to pay the Bills allowed against said fund at a regular meeting of said Board held on the second day of February 1914 a list of which may be found on page 127 of the Journal of the proceedings of the Board on said date.

Sec III

That the sum of Sixty Six ^{and 87/100} Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Street Fund to pay the Bills allowed against said fund at a regular meeting of said Board held on the second day of February 1914 a list of which may be found on page 127 of the Journal of the proceedings of the Board on that date.

Sec IV That the sum of One Hundred and Forty $\frac{00}{100}$ dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Electric Light funds to pay the Bills allowed against said funds at a regular meeting of said Board held on the second day of February 1914 a list of which may be found on page 126 of the Journal of the proceedings of the Board on said date.

Sec V That the ~~Mayor~~ and City Clerk be and are hereby authorized and instructed to draw warrants on the City Treasurer to pay the Bills allowed in sections One Two Three and Four of this Ordinance

Sec IV That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by the Board of Commissioners and its approval by the Mayor.
