They were first drawn to the island by quarry operations and ran a quarry boarding house nearby. After the shut-down of the quarry they maintained a permanent residence at ERI-1621 and pursued commercial fishing. The builder was Jack Sennish, born on Kelleys Island in 1885.		40.
