# The 38th Annual 9-Pin "No Tap" Charity challenge 

## TOURNAMENT RULES

The 38th Annual 9-pin "No-Tap" Charity Challenge is operated by Beaver-Vu Bowl. All net proceeds will benefit Shiners Chiledren's. This tournament is open to any adult male, female, or youth bowler. Walk-in's will be allowed without penalty subject to lane availability. USBC membership is not required to bowl in this tournament.
Format: Qualifying Round - All participants will bowl three (3), 9-pin "no-tap" games in a qualifying round on the dates listed with a 9 pin count on the 1st ball in each frame scored as a strike. The top forty-eight (48) 3-game series qualifying round scores (which will include no fewer than two (2) women and two (2) youth bowlers) will advance to the Championship Finals. Each squad leader will get an automatic Championship Round entry. Ties for advancing positions to the Championship Finals will be broken by the highest one (1) game rolled in the Qualifying Round. Bowlers may enter this tournament as often as desired.
Championship Finals - All Championship Round games will be 9-pin "no-tap" games. Round 1: 48 bowlers will bowl two (2), 9pin "no-tap" games. 4 bowlers will be assigned to a pair by random draw. The highest 2 game pinfall from each pair will advance to Round 2. Round 2: 24 bowlers will bowl 1 game head-to-head to advance 12 bowlers to Round 3. Round 3: 12 bowless will bowl 1 game head-to-head to advance 6 bowlers to Round 4. Round 4: 6 bowlers will bowl 1 game head-to-head to advance 3 bowlers to the Championship Round. Championship Round: 3 bowlers will bowl 1 game to determine 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place. All ties for advancing positions in a Championship round will be broken by a 9th/10th frame roll-off.
Scoring: All scores will be recorded on an actual (scratch) basis. Handicap will not be used.
Cost: The entry fee is $\$ 30.00$. If a bowler wishes to reenter the cost is $\$ 25.00$. All youth awards will be SMART scholarships (Account \#8871). Beaver-Vu Bowl is donating facility use for this event and all prize awards.
Communications: The final results of this tournament will be posted on daytonbowling.com. All decisions by the Tournament Director are final based on the accepted rules of bowling and the best interests of this charity event.
