

Aftercare

All tattoos heal, peel and fade and shrink. Expect 30-40% color-loss for shaded tattoo areas and 10% color-loss for microbladed tattoo areas. 90 % of all Initial procedures require one follow-up, occasionally two follow-ups depending on movement, breathing, tense muscles during the procedure and homecare. Previous work by another artist is considered corrective work. The number of follow-ups on corrective work is determined on individual basis. **Apply thin coating of Vaseline or Aquaphor by Eucerin . Application Schedule: 5 X a day+ for 5 to 10 days.**

- Do not expose procedure area to water without coating of Vaseline or Aquifer, if exposed to water immediately apply Vaseline or Aquifer.
- Do not soak the area in the bath, swimming pool or hot tub for 10 days.
- Do not exercise for 5 days.
- Do not expose procedure area to ocean water, pool water, lake water, etc. for 10 days.
- Do not expose treated area to water in the shower. Apply extra barrier prior to shower. Then remove and reapply.
- Absolutely no AHAs, cleansing creams or beauty creams for 7 days.
- Don't scrub or peel, pick, pluck, tweeze, wax for 10 days.
- Use non-stick gauze bandages at night to cover eyebrow procedures from getting stuck to your pillow case for 4 days.
- Protect the area from UV light (sun and tanning beds) using hat, sunscreen, sunglasses, or put your hand or anything between your tattoo and the sun. Permanent makeup tattoos lose pigment faster than body art tattoos due to thinness of the skin covering the pigments.
- ***Eyeliner Procedure:*** No mascara for 72 hours with new tube. No contacts for 24 with new or disinfected contacts.
- ***Lip Shading Procedure:*** Avoid greasy, oily, acidic, or salty foods, and hot/steamy beverages. If possible, drink through a straw, avoid tooth paste on lips...spit quick. You may apply lip shade as long as it is new after 24 hrs.

Aftercare contributes to quality of your outcome, and the contract you signed states you understand that the outcome is undetermined and not guaranteed, especially on previous work from other artists aka corrective work.
