## AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PEDDLING AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 83-8 ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PEDDLERS, CONVASSERS AND SOLICITORS

Be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chapin, Morgan County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1**. Ordinance No. 83-8, entitled Ordinance Regulating Peddlers, Canvassers and Solicitors, is hereby repealed.

**SECTION 2**. Except as provided for in this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person, partnership, corporation or other entity to engage in business as a peddler within the Village.

SECTION 3. The word "peddler" as used in this section shall mean any person, whether a resident of this Village or not, traveling from place to place, from house to house or from street to street, for the purpose of selling or soliciting for sale, goods, wares, merchandise or services; and shall also mean and include any person transacting a temporary business within the Village at an established place of business. The word "peddler" shall include the terms "solicitor", "hawker", "transient or itinerant merchant or vendor" or "transient or itinerant photographer" and, except as provided for in Section 4 of this ordinance, shall include solicitors for charitable causes.

SECTION 4. This ordinance does not prohibit solicitations, sales or distributions made by charitable, educational or religious organizations which have their principal place of activity in the Village and/or are related to Triopia Community Unit School District #27. This ordinance does not prohibit the selling or soliciting for sale, goods, wares or merchandise during a Village-wide special event such as Chapin Big Country

Days, provided that prior permission to sell or solicit for sale, goods, wares or merchandise at such Village-wide special event is given by the Corporate Authorities.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
