Lester V. Alexander, age 86 of Elkton, passed away Tuesday, March 3 at Huron County Medical Care Facility in Bad Axe after a short illness.

He was born Aug. 15, 1905 in Chandler Township, son of the late George and Emma (Bouck) Alexander. He was united in marriage to Catherine Karr in 1929. She preceded him in death in 1941.

He married Ethel Abbe on March 1, 1947. Mr. Alexander owned and operated the Sunoco Station in Elkton from 1935-48. From 1948 until his retirement in 1974, he bought and sold livestock at his business along Elkton Road.

Surviving are his wife, Ethel; one son, Robert of Bay Port; one daughter, Mrs. Ed (Marjorie) Dahringer of Howell; seven grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.
