****Emergency Overnight Shelters Information****

The shelters work on a first-come-first-serve basis for same-night entry. This availability changes daily. It is helpful to have a scan card before being admitted into a shelter (*see schedule above*). Many shelters have longer-term programs while receiving case management or working toward employment/housing. Please take a look at the shelter case managers for details.

Presbyterian Night Shelter:

- Bring State ID and scan Card (*please get in touch with the shelter for additional verifications of credentials accepted*)

Union Gospel Mission:

Salvation Army Mabee:

True Worth Place (Day Homeless Resource Center):

True Worth Place is to be a central resource facility for people experiencing homelessness. True Worth Place offers its guests a safe and clean day shelter and critical services. Basic services include:

- Restroom and Showers
- Laundry Facilities
- Mailing Address/ Checking Mail
- Telephones
- Computers
- Temporary storage
- True Worth Place links guests with health care, employment, education, mental health, substance abuse treatment, benefits, etc.

****The Emergency Shelters have their own policies and procedures with service animals in the shelters; you may need to contact the shelters to determine eligibility.****

I have included Public Housing (open to the public) for Section 8 and low-income housing assistance.
