Essential Duties/Responsibilities for Plant:

- Operates rock, sand and gravel plant to batch, crush, or segregate materials.
- Moves controls on panel board or control board to control feeding, crushing, and sifting machinery in sand and gravel plant.
- Observes gauges, dials and operation of machinery to ensure conformance to processing specifications.
- Assists in maintenance of plant equipment and in compiling reports regarding plant production and plant maintenance.
- Must be able to climb stairs/ladders to top of plant.
- Uses tools such as sledge hammer, wrench, screwdriver, cutting torch, welder, pneumatic hammer/drill, sand blaster, pipe wrench.
- Must be able to operate loader, dozer, run scale house, clean screens on conveyor belts and other duties necessary to maintain plant in operating order.
- Answers telephone, radio, and takes and inputs orders.
- Properly follow all company policies and OSHA/MSHA regulations for safe working procedures and environment.
- Follow directions of Supervisor as to daily tasks and expectations for each specific project or jobsite.
- Perform daily pre-and-post inspections with appropriate documentation in compliance with company policies.
- Assist in training less-experienced employees on the proper operations, servicing and repair of equipment to further their abilities.
- Other duties as assigned.

The ideal candidate will:

- Pass pre-employment drug screen
- Pass a pre-employment "Fit for Work" physical.
- Be able to provide valid documentation for the I-9 Immigration document.
- Display a professional and courteous attitude to co-workers, supervisors and the general public at all times.
- Report to work at the designated start time.
- Must be willing to travel and work away from home when required.
