Trust In Man, Or Trust In God? | Sunday Service 02/16/2025



We struggle in our culture. As infants and young children, we place all of our trust in our parents or guardians. We trust that they will treat us right, feed us, clothe us, and keep us safe from harm. Then we become teenagers and our trust is pulled in other directions by friends and those of authority around us. We graduate and go off to college, work or go into the military, and again our trust is pulled in another direction by the people we surround ourselves with.

This pattern of trusting what we see around us and is tangible to us, is also problematic. If we have been brought up in the church, we know we

are to trust God and Jesus. We have heard those stories time and time again. But at times we feel that God and Jesus are not near and so we gravitate to what is near. Like the north end of a magnet being pulled away by a south end of another magnet, we can lose our sense of direction and right and wrong.

Last week we talked about the consequences of not following Jesus. This week we look at some of the reasons we may trust man as opposed to God. Those consequences are dire, even though it may be hard of us to imagine right now.


Want to Get Involved? Here's How!
