

Entry Dead Line: Please enter online at the last region rodeo. If you do not enter at last rodeo will have to contact state office 979-412-2551. No entries will be accepted after April 11, 2026.

MATCH SCHEDULE

The Light Rifle Contest will be on Saturday, May 23, 2026. These contestants will need to check into the Rodeo office beginning Friday 8am – 4pm and Saturday 8am – 4pm. If you can not check in during these times you need to make advance arrangements with Anne Dollery at 979-412-2551.

The shoot draw will be posted the first of May 2026 on the website www.tjhra.net

Awards: There will be 1st round top 6 buckles and 6 buckles awarded to the average winners – the top 4 will be awarded at the National Banquet on Saturday 5/30.

Shooting Positions: Prone, Kneeling and Standing. One minute time for prone and kneeling and one half minute for standing. The targets will be set at 50 yards. Number of 12 shots in each position.

Rules: Current NRA Light Rifle Rules will apply. Eye and ear protection is mandatory for all competitors while on firing line.

Rifles: Rifles MUST be inspected prior to practicing or competition.

Ammunition and Targets: Range will provide ONLY targets. You must bring your own ammunition and it will be inspected prior to using.

Note: These rules are provided for the conduct of light rifle competition. Scores fired in this competition will be used for classification. In all cases where specific rules are not given here, the appropriate rules for smallbore rifle competition shall be used. In light rifle competition, the goal is to achieve the highest possible score within the confines of the allowed equipment.

3.3 Light Rifle – Any rifle chambered for .22 caliber rimfire rifle cartridges only, a trigger pull of not less than two (2) pounds and weight not more than eight and one-half (8 ½) pounds. *Note: Tournament sponsors are authorized to restrict competitors to the use of only bolt action rifles if required by range regulations.*

3.12 Clothing – shooting coats or trousers are not allowed. Shoulder pads may be worn if not to provide artificial support. Gloves may be worn if not providing artificial support. Jeans/long pants or trousers are required as are long-sleeved, button-down, western type shirts and “closed toe” footwear (Absolutely NO flip-flops, open toed shoes OR SHORTS are allowed.)

GROUND RULES FOR J. B. WELLS ARENA - GONZALES, TX

1. Covered arena will NOT be open for practice at any time; however, the practice arena will be open for riding day and night.
2. For the safety of your horses, we ask that you NOT clip or tie horses to chain link fences anywhere on the grounds at any time. Also, NO horses are allowed on grass area around the cemetery.
3. **RV PARKING SPOTS – ONCE YOU ARE PARKED YOU MAY NOT MOVE** – they will be marking your RV and keeping the number you are in on file at the office – **IF YOU MOVE YOU WILL BE ESCORTED OFF THE GROUNDS AND WILL HAVE TO GO FIND SOMEWHERE ELSE FOR YOUR RV FOR THE WEEK** – you will be able to come on grounds to make a run but will have to leave after your run – **THIS WILL BE ENFORCED TO THE FULLEST**
4. If you park in a RV spot and plan to run your generator you still have to pay for the spot. No generators are allowed to be ran overnight.
5. NO horses are allowed to be washed inside the horse stall barn. Horses can only be washed in the wash racks, located at the end of the Show Barn and the North corner of the big horse stall barn.
6. There will not be a honey wagon. Every RV spot has water, sewer, and electric hook-ups. Majority each spot has a 20, 30, and 50 amp service. There are some on the lower side that only have 50 amp service, so adapters may be needed.
7. For the safety and because the practice arena is available at all times, NO horses are allowed to be left in the practice arena over night. If a horse is on the premises over night they must be in a stall.
8. Bicycles, scooters, and roller blades are not allowed to be ridden in the bleacher area at any time.
9. Please don't stand at the rail around the arena. Be considerate of the spectators in the bleachers and handicap areas that came to support you.
10. NO GLASS CONTAINERS ALLOWED ANYWHERE IN THE PARK.
11. All dogs on park grounds must be on a leash. **NO DOGS IN THE ARENA AT ANY TIME**
12. No horses are allowed on sidewalk area or tied close by. These areas are for spectators.
13. NO SHAVINGS IN THE TRASH CANS AND SHAVINGS WILL NOT BE PICKED UP AT YOUR STALLS. – PLEASE PLACE AT THE END OF STALLS WHERE THE SIGN DESIGNATES

2026 TJHRA STATE FINALS

In addition to the 2024 – 2026 RULE BOOK OF THE NHSRA & THJHRA, plus GROUND RULES FROM THE CITY OF GONZALES: the following will be Ground Rules at the 2025 TJHRA STATE FINALS – Gonzales, Texas – May 22 – May 30, 2026.

1. All contestants must bring either their final report card for the 2025-2026 school year, or the **last previous six weeks report card**, or a letter from the school (on school stationary with school seal) stating that they are passing 70% of their subjects. The letter must be signed by **school counselor, principal or superintendent**.
2. Any contestant having a problem making the check in time on Sunday, May 24th, 2026 needs to call Anne Dollery (State Secretary) at 979-412-2551. ANY LATE ARRIVAL MUST BE **PREAPPROVED**. **If you show up without talking to Anne Dollery (state secretary) YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN STATE FINALS!**
3. Check in will be Sunday, May 24th from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. at the Expo. You must be checked in by 12 p.m. Campers and/or horses cannot be brought in and left on grounds or in stalls before Friday morning, **May 22, 2026, starting at 8:00 AM** This is open to anyone who wants to come on Friday but please note that the entrance gate will **close at 7:00 PM on Friday** and will not open back up until 7:00 AM Saturday morning. The City of Gonzales will have staff available 24 hours to help you with RV and stall assignment. **When they take you to your assigned stall they will then take you to your region's RV area, anyone refusing to park in that area or move after they are parked they will be asked to leave the grounds and will not be allowed to park their trailer on the grounds.**
 - a. There will no refunds after **May 1st (entry fee, stall or rv reservation)** without a medical release, and there will be no moving up after **May 15th** if a contestant drops out for any reason.
 - b. Each contestant will have a morning and afternoon run. The order will be reversed for the second go. The second go will not start until the first go is complete.
 - c. The first performance will be on Sunday, May 24 at 5pm, then we will go to 2 performances a day. The morning perfs will start at 8:30 a.m. and the afternoon perfs will start at 2:30p.m. The Short Go will start at 11 a.m. Saturday, May 30th and will be the only performance that day.
4. Proof of negative coggins test, taken within the 12 months prior to the State Finals, must be furnished along with a proper and current Health Certificate issued **if you are crossing state lines** by a licensed veterinarian within 45 days of the opening of the State Finals. Only one (1) horse will be allowed in each stall. **A copy of these must be turned in when you get your stall assignment. PLEASE BRING A COPY!**
5. The price of admission will be \$8.00 for adults and \$5.00 for a child for a performance. Season passes are \$60 for adults and \$40 for child and may be purchased from your region secretary when you turn in your entry form. Passes can be picked up when you check in. They will also be available for purchase at the finals.
6. The Dress Code will be as follows:
 - a. Full Dress code inside the fenced arena (hats, boots, long sleeves, and back numbers) while competing or sitting in the stands.
 - b. Back Number only in the stalling area and jack pot arena.

7. There will no tolerance for alcohol/drug/tobacco consumption or in presence thereof.
8. Saving RV Spaces – No vehicle may park in areas where RV hookups are located. There will be no “saving” of RV spaces for your friends or family etc. If you want to park by someone, you must arrive there together. **Again, anyone caught moving their trailer and/or camper once parked by the City of Gonzales personnel may be asked to leave the premises.**
9. Non-Licensed Vehicles – There will be no scooters, personal golf carts, mules or 4 wheelers are allowed on the grounds without prior written approval of the Executive Board. The only non-licensed vehicles will be golf carts rented on premises. The first fifty registered through Metro Golf personal golf carts will be allowed, the charge will be \$250 and they will be stickered. **ANY CARTS THAT ARE CAUGHT WITHOUT A STICKER WILL BE SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS.**





GOLF CART RENTAL RULES

The following rules & regulations for golf cart usage will be in effect for 2023. Enforcement will be held by Texas JHSFRA, event venue staff, and Metro Golf Cars, Inc. staff. Clients will receive one warning for minor infractions before having the golf cart confiscated with no rental refund. Serious infractions will result in immediate confiscation of golf carts and loss of rental immediately without any warning. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN IF GOLF CART IS CONFISCATED FOR NOT FOLLOWING ANY/ALL RULES.**

1. **ONLY SELECT PERSONAL GOLF CARTS WILL BE ALLOWED AND SUBJECT TO SECURITY AND RULES ENFORCEMENT. MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED AND APPROVED BEFORE THE EVENT.**
2. All Metro Golf Cars, Inc. must be registered, credentialed, and permitted. The permit must be prominently displayed on the golf cart.
3. All drivers must be a minimum of 16 years of age and be in possession of a valid driver's license to operate a golf cart or will risk the vehicle being confiscated and will only be released to an adult with such credentials.
4. Drivers must show proof of age and license or their authorized wristband if stopped by security.
5. There is a 1:30 am curfew on golf cart usage for anyone 21 years and under at the High School Finals Rodeo. There is no restriction on golf cart usage by parents or adult guardians.
6. There are several off-limits areas on the event grounds. Restricted areas will be signed and flagged as such, and golf cart use is prohibited in these areas. Golf carts are not permitted off the grounds or on public roads. Golf carts are not allowed inside barns or tents at any time. Golf carts found in prohibited areas will be confiscated immediately and reported to officials.
7. Metro Golf Cars, Inc. recommends renters bring a cable lock and lock the cart up when not in use as keys are interchangeable and many golf carts are the same color. This will help you keep up with the cart you rent under your responsibility. Metro Golf Cars, Inc. is not responsible for lost/stolen golf carts.
8. Do not, under any circumstances, lend your golf cart to an unauthorized driver. If it is stolen, you will still be responsible for all costs for damage or for the cost of the golf cart which will be collected immediately.
9. Golf carts will be inspected upon check out for pre-existing damage. You will be responsible for all damage beyond those noted and agreed upon at check out. A \$50 fee will be assessed to any customer whose golf cart is returned with decorations/signs, residue from adhesives and/or excessive mud. **NO SILLY STRING**, it is very damaging to seats and bodies of the golf carts. There are no refunds for early returns.
10. You are responsible for removing and throwing away all trash prior to checking in at the end of the event.

 - g. utility truck golf cart - 2 people only; none shall occupy the utility bed as it is not designed nor rated for passengers

Region Participation: Each region will send two Adults per region to assist with the event.

- 8 Adult per court
 - (4) 1 person on each corner calling lines
 - (2) 1 person keeping score on each court
 - (2) 1 person as the REf on each court
 - (1) Helping helping round up regions playing/correct players from list and managing that they are rotating correctly during game.
- 8 people to manage boundaries for parents.
- 1 person managing tournament board
- 3 people to check in teams

GENERAL FORMAT:

1. Play will consist of a SINGLE elimination tournament to determine co- champions.
 - a. Co- Champions will advance to final two.
2. The two co-champions will play a SINGLE elimination tournament to determine the "Texas Junior High Finals Rodeo Volleyball Champions"
3. Matches will consist of the best two out of three games.
4. Each game will be played to 11 points. Teams must win by two points with a cap at 13 (if the score is 12-12, the next point will win). The third game will be progressive scoring.
5. Matches will be 30 minutes long. At the end of the 30 minutes, the team that is ahead by more than two (2) points will be declared the winner of the game. If no team is ahead by two (2) points, the game will continue using progressive scoring until a team is ahead by two (2) points. In the event that a third game is necessary, the next game will be progressive scoring with the first team to seven (7) being declared the winner.
6. In the finals of each co-champions tournament and the finals of the Final Two tournament, all matches will be two out three to 15 with a 60 minute time limit.

TOURNAMENT RULES:

All rules not covered below will be from the National Federation of State High School Associations Volleyball Rule Book.

Page 2 - Volleyball

1. Teams may have a minimum of four (4) players and a maximum of eight (8) players plus 1 coach.
2. Only 6 Players can play on the court. You can have 2 alternates (subs). Must have equal number of male and female on the court at all times. It MUST be the SAME 8 players/subs throughout entire tournament.
3. One time-out per team per game.
4. Teams must maintain a consistent rotation.
5. Double hits will be called.
6. National Federation Rules regarding player conduct will be enforced.
7. **All referee decisions are final. No protests will be allowed!!!**
8. Game time is forfeit time.
9. Volleyball team members must wear contestant back number while playing.
10. The tournament director is the final authority on all decisions regarding the game, rules or any other dispute involved in the tournament.
11. A coin toss at the beginning of the match will determine who serves first.
12. Parents/Adults are not allowed to protest, communicate with the teams, or anyone working the tournament. There will be an Adult line that you will not be able to cross. Anyone not following this rule will result in their Regions being disqualified for the rest of the tournament and any additional games offered at the TJHRA Finals. Those adults working the tournament will be identified by an official badge.
