





THE CATECHISM OF THE **CATHOLIC CHURCH**

The Fruits of Holy Communion



"given up for us," and the blood we drink "shed for the many for the forgiveness of sins." For this reason the Eucharist cannot unite us to Christ without at the same time cleansing us from past sins and preserving us from future sins: For as often as we eat this bread and drink the cup, we proclaim the death of the Lord. If we proclaim the Lord's death, we proclaim the forgiveness of sins. If, as often as his blood is poured out, it is poured for the forgiveness of sins, I should always receive it, so that it may always forgive my sins. Because I always sin, I should always have a remedy.

CATECISMO DE LA IGLESIA CATOLICA

1393 La comunión nos separa del pecado. El Cuerpo de Cristo que recibimos en la comunión es "entregado por nosotros", y la Sangre que bebemos es "derramada por muchos para el perdón de los pecados". Por eso la Eucaristía no puede unirnos a Cristo sin purificarnos al mismo tiempo de los pecados cometidos y preservarnos de futuros pecados: «Cada vez que lo recibimos, anunciamos la muerte del Señor (cf. 1 Co 11,26). Si anunciamos la muerte del Señor, anunciamos también el perdón de los pecados. Si cada vez que su Sangre es derramada, lo es para el perdón de los pecados, debo recibirle siempre, para que siempre me perdone los pecados. Yo que peco siempre, debo tener siempre un remedio» (San Ambrosio, De sacramentis 4, 28).
