Winemaking

- **Harvest:** Grapes are harvested exclusively in the morning and sorted twice to ensure quality.
- **Vinification:** 'Pressurage direct' is used for Cinsault, Grenache, and Rolle. The Syrah is partially vinified using the saignée method. 95% of the wine is vinified in temperature-controlled stainless steel vats, with the remaining 5% in barrels with batonnage.

- **Appearance:** Magnificent bright rose-gold color with silver undertones.
- **Aroma:** Elegant bouquet with notes of hibiscus and amaryllis, combined with aromas of vine peaches.
- **Palate:** Silky texture with a beautiful balance and flavors of crunchy fruit, complemented by minerality with saline and limestone notes.
- **Finish:** Outstanding length with an elegant and refined finish.
- **Aging Potential:** Best enjoyed now.
