PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice or other event.
- I will place the emotional and physical wellbeing of my child ahead of a personal desire to win. I will be in control of my emotions at all times.
- I will remain in the spectator area when required.
- I will insist that my child play in safe and healthy environment.
- I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all. I will not advise coaches on how to do their job.
- I will expect a sports environment for my child that is free of drugs, tobacco and alcohol, and will refrain from their use at all youth sports events. I will not drink alcohol at events or come to events having drank too much.
- I will remember that the game is for our youth - **NOT ADULTS**. Participation in youth sports is a privilege, not a right. I will show respect for all participants at all times.
- I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child. I will not instruct him/her to harm any other participants willingly.
- I will not coach my child during events.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability. I will not making insulting comments to players, parents, coaches or officials from either team.
- I promise to help my child enjoy the youth sports experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectable fan, assisting with coaching a
- or providing transportation.
- I will thank the coaches, officials and other volunteers who have conducted the event.
- I understand that my responsibilities include setting an example for children and that any breach of those responsibilities will result in my inability to attend games or practices if deemed necessary by the program coordinators.
- If there is an issue or concern, I will make an appointment with the coach no later then 24 hours following the event. And I will treat the coach with the same respect that I expect to be treated during this meeting.
