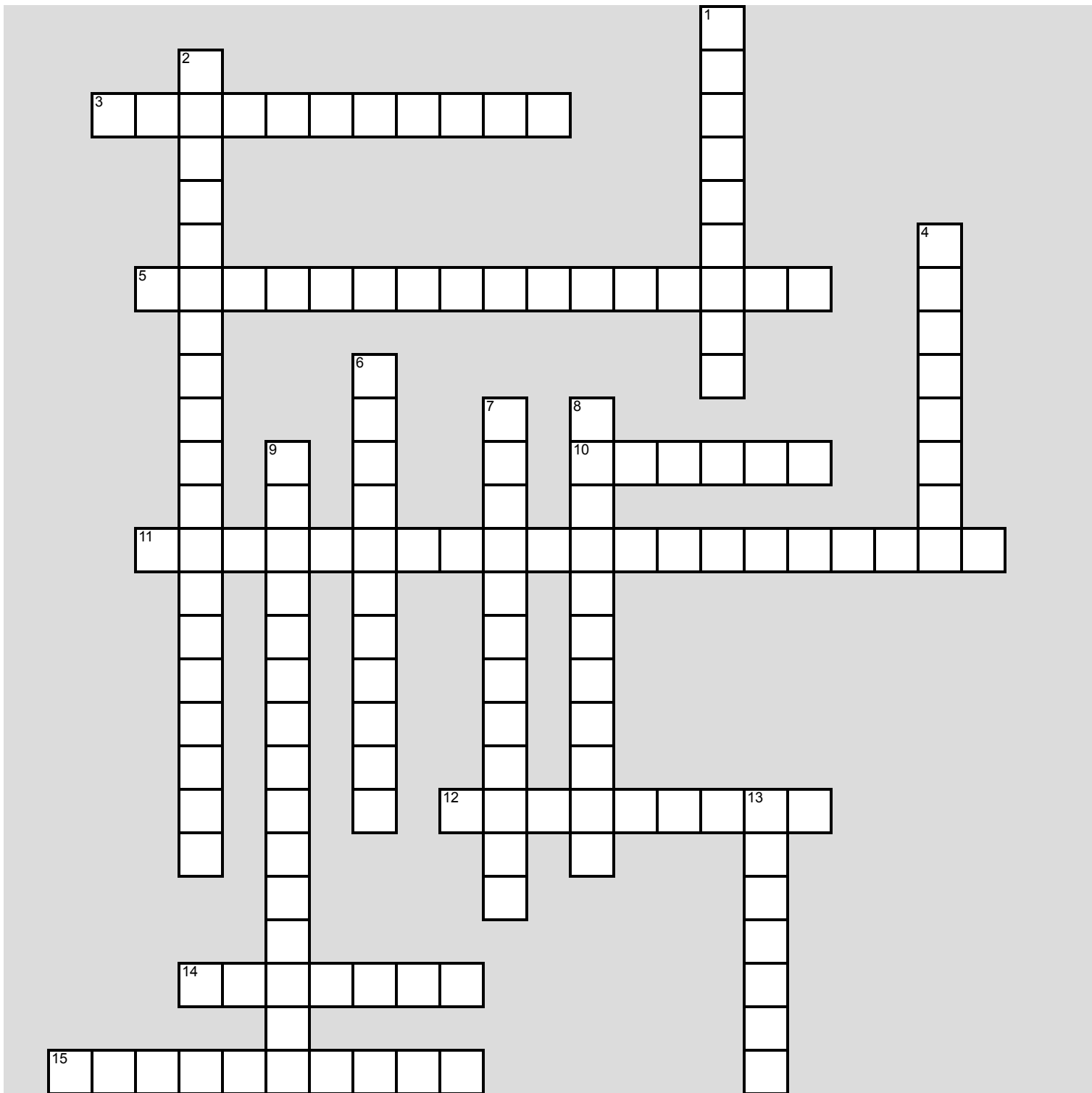


American Revolution in the Mohawk Valley
