A graduate of Lesley College in Cambridge, MA, where he studied theatre history, Christopher has also received training in stage management at Colorado Mountain College.



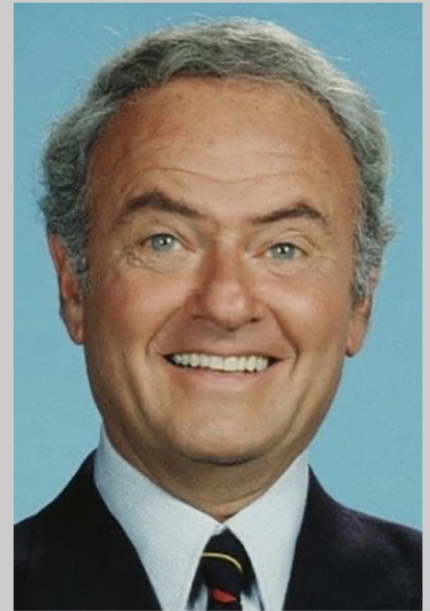

Harvey Korman (1927-2008)

Harvey Herschel Korman, born in Chicago, Illinois, was a comedic genius whose talents spanned television, film, and voice acting. He left an indelible mark on the entertainment industry, remembered for his sharp wit, impeccable timing, and unforgettable performances.

Korman's career began with roles on popular television shows such as "The Danny Kaye Show" and "The Lucy Show." It was his collaboration with Carol Burnett on "The Carol Burnett Show" that truly showcased his comedic prowess. From 1967 to 1977, Korman entertained audiences as a main cast member on the CBS sketch comedy series, winning four Primetime Emmy Awards and a Golden Globe Award for his work.

In addition to his success on "The Carol Burnett Show," Korman starred in his own sitcom, "The Harvey Korman Show," in 1980. He continued to collaborate with his "The Carol Burnett Show" castmates on projects like "The Tim Conway Show" (1980) and "Mama's Family" (1983-1984), further solidifying his status as a comedy legend.

Korman's talents weren't limited to television, as he also made a significant impact on the big screen. He starred in several comedy films by Mel Brooks, including "Blazing Saddles" (1974), "High Anxiety" (1977), and "History of the World, Part 1" (1981).

Korman was also known for his distinctive voice, lending his talents to iconic characters such as The Great Gazoo in "The Flintstones" (1965-1966).
