2025 Roto Grip Raider Classic Bowling Tournament



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Tournament Rules

Eligibility: This tournament is sanctioned by the USBC-Collegiate Program and will be in compliance with their rules and regulations of tournament conduct. All teams sanctioned by the USBC Collegiate Bowling Program are eligible to participate in this tournament.

Team Participation: The number of men's and/or women's teams representing a school is limited to 3 teams (1 Varsity and 2 JV) per division. All schools must designate their Varsity team in each division prior to competition. Only Varsity teams will be eligible for TRS points. Depending on the number of teams, the tournament may have a separate lane assignment schedule for Varsity and JV. Both Varsity and JV categories in both divisions will have team awards and All Tournament teams. Priority will be given to varsity teams, then JV1 teams and finally JV2 teams.

Divisions: There are two (2) divisions in this tournament. The men's division and the women's division. Teams consisting of mixed gender will compete in the men's division.

Team Roster: A team must have a minimum of five (5) eligible bowlers and a maximum of eight (8) eligible bowlers.

Substitutions: A team may substitute no more than three (3) bowlers in any regular or Baker game. Once removed, a player may not return to the line-up until the start of the next regular or Baker game.

Attire: All shirts must consist of collared, v-neck, rib-lined or banded necklines only. USBC Collegiate ITC and ISC team uniforms and dress code rules 503 and 607 apply for all players and USBC Coaches attire rule 504 applies for all coaches.

Food & Drink: Beaver Vu Bowl has a NO carry in food and drink policy. Teams are permitted to bring in bottled water, Gatorade, finger food, cookies, crackers, etc., BUT NO FAST FOOD (Subway, McDonalds, Pizza Hut, etc.) is allowed. We ask that all team members, coaches, parents and spectators be respectful of this policy.

Spectators: Per Beaver Vu policy, spectators are NOT allowed to bring ladders, step stools or lounge chairs to maximize concourse space.

Cost: The entry fee is \$225.00 per team. Breakdown: Cost of Bowling: \$175.00. Awards and Expenses: \$50.00.

Awards: The top five (5) men and top five (5) women in BOTH the Varsity and JV categories will be identified as members of the Roto Grip Raider Classic All-Tournament Teams. Ties for All-Tournament Team recognition will be broken by high game score.

Tournament Format

Qualifying Rounds: All teams in both categories and both divisions will bowl four (4) games of tenpin bowling on Saturday and sixteen (16) games of Baker-format bowling on Sunday. The Baker games will be organized into four (4) sets of four (4) games.

Eliminator Finals: The top four teams in each category and division based on total pins in the qualifying rounds will compete in an eliminator format. If there is a tie for any spot, the tiebreaker will be the higher baker block followed by the higher baker set. The semifinal round will consist of all 4 teams bowling 4 baker games on 4 lanes. Teams 1 and 4 and teams 2 and 3 will bowl on each lane of their starting pair and then flip to the other pair. The top two teams based on the 4 game pinfall will move to the finals. The final round will consist of 2 baker games on a new pair of lanes. Champion will be determined by the 2 game total pinfall. The higher seed will choose the starting lane in each round. All ties in the semis and finals will be broken by a 9th/10th frame roll-off. Each team's players will receive one shot on each lane of starting pair during warm-up (no re-racks please) for the semis and finals.
