Mayor Russell Wood, Jr. called to order the Village of Bloomingburg Board of Trustees Meeting of February 13th, 2020 at 6:30 pm in the Village of Bloomingburg Hall, Bloomingburg, N.Y.

The meeting was open with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Regular Meeting

The minutes from the January 9th, 2020 meeting were all reviewed by board.

Mayor Wood asked for a motion to approve the minutes from January.

Aaron Rabiner made the motion and was seconded by Samuel Weingarten.

The minutes from January were all approved.

The monthly abstracts for the general and sewer bills were all reviewed by the Board of Trustees.

Mayor Russell Wood, Jr. asked for a motion to approve all the monthly abstracts for the month of January.

Aaron Rabiner made the motion and was seconded by Samuel Weingarten. All in favor the January abstracts were approved.

Public Hearing

Mayor Wood asked for a motion to open the Public Hearing for Local Law #7 of 2019. Aaron Rabiner made the motion and was seconded by Samuel Weingarten. All in Favor, Aye. Public Hearing is now open.

Mayor Wood explained that after the close of the December meeting there was a Petition that had been signed to return the terms of the elected positions back to a 2 year term from the proposed change of the term length of 4 years. Attorney Alex Smith stated he would make the resolution for Local Law #7 to be repealed.

It has been determined that there will be NO zoning changes within the next 90 days. There will be a Comprehensive Workshop held on Wednesday January 15, 2020 at 10:30am. Motion to accept Aaron Rabiner seconded by Samuel Weingarten. All in Favor, Aye.

Mayors Report:

There will be a Public hearing regarding Charter Communication March 12th, 2020 at 6:30 pm.

Mayor Woods met with the Chestnut Ridge Water Report regarding pumphouse, well tank, etc.

The sidewalk from Market Street to Chestnut Ridge – Mayor Woods is reviewing the County Highway law

Public Comment:

Chris Lester: Mayor Wood how many fire hydrants are in the Village?

Mayor Woods: The Village of Bloomingburg or Chestnut Ridge

Chris Lester: Both, are they flushed regularly?

Mayor Wood: I don't know a number off the top of my head Chris, but the hydrants are flushed every year.

Chris Lester: Will the new sidewalks effect the hydrants?

Mayor Wood: No Chris the sidewalks will not be effected by the hydrants

Village elections will be on March 18th, 2020 from 12pm-8pm. Election has been moved from Tuesday due to elections falling on St. Patrick's Day.
