Our first run was in the warm up jackpot as we haven't had the opportunity to make many runs on a standard pattern. She felt good, cruising through to be a 17.8. From there I wanted to build on that confidence. The first go of the futurity she stepped off first and struggled a bit on third. Coming into the second go of the futurity I called my daughter Colby Gilbert for some insight as she saw my first run in the futurity. Her only advice was to ride her to the backside and let her work. I did just that and Star felt outstanding running my own personal best time on a standard of 17.2 to be the fastest run of the weekend and win us the futurity. Coming out of the arena I was absolutely thrilled. Her run felt just as I had hoped for--smooth and efficient. Having had a lot of success in Canada in the past, it was a new goal for me to have success across the line as well. Star fulfilled that goal for me and I am so thankful for her.

PEPNICS FRENCH GAL is owned by Kristen Cote and has had a few great hands that have contributed to her success. Star was first started by cow horse trainer Taylor Douglas who put an outstanding handle on her. I admire him for the great work he does. She was then given to Krystal Grad to start on barrels. Krystal too did a great job starting her and getting her exposed. From the beginning Star was a natural at anything she did and took to the barrel racing game easily. Having seen Star in the past, I knew she had the potential to be a standout futurity horse. Matched with her natural ability and bold, confident demeanor, I believe she is one of those horses that will shine no matter what is thrown at her.

HURDLES, QUIRKS, SETBACKS... Since getting Star the beginning of May it has been a constant struggle to keep her soft in the ribcage.

As I said before Star is a very confident, bold mare. She naturally wants to be very elevated and fast in a turn. Keeping her soft, relaxed and correct in a turn is a goal we have in the practice pen. This in turn helps her to be more efficient and lay down the runs I know she is capable of. As for Star's personality, she does not have many quirks. She is an easy mare to haul and have around which makes my job very easy. The excitement of getting to have a hand in this mare's success is truly a blessing. She is one, I believe, to watch out for in the future and I am so thankful to my great friend Kristen for the opportunity.

I have had the opportunity to run many great horses in the last 5 years, all having success in the futurities. I do believe however, that Pepnics French Gal is special. She is one that loves her job and wants to work anywhere despite any obstacles she may be faced with. She is a very mature 5year-old and I expect her to have a lot more success in the future.

The main goal I have when starting a horse is to instill the confidence in them to be great and give them the stepping-stones to work on their own. When working my colts I want a rate point where they relax and soften. I want them to ride up into the bridle and soften in the ribcage. I ensure not to cut off the backside of my turn and once at the backside I allow them to leave strong. I try to keep my program as easy as possible and it is also very important to me that others have success behind my training. The horses I have had the most success on are cow horses crossed with run. I want a natural rate in my horse as well as elevation. Star has crossed over easily into my program because of her great confirmation and natural ability. I contribute my success to all the great mentors that have influenced me such as Dave Elliot. I believe clinics are important to keep a person open minded and constantly growing.

A mentor I have had since childhood is the great Dave Elliot. I have had the opportunity to learn from Dave and that is why nothing goes in my horse's mouth other than a Dave Elliot bit. I feel the quality is second to none and I am so thankful for his guidance and knowledge. As for saddles, I recently came into contact with Clell and Joan Usher. Their saddles suit my style and allow me to always feel confident that I will be there to help my horses wherever needed. Actually, Joan sent me a new saddle up to Kalispell and that was the first weekend I had ever sat in it. I think that attests to the quality of their saddles as well. Needing something to take the edge off Star and keep her relaxed, I contacted Ivy Redfield about Oxy-Zen. Using this product for the first weekend and having so much success, I anticipate it will always be a product I have in my barn.

My goals have changed slightly. I would like to attend a few more futurities down in the states as well as some of the bigger races in Canada. My passion however, is teaching; so I will continue to host clinics as much as possible between the races I plan to attend.
