First Reading

We have eaten and drank with the risen Christ.

Reading from the Book of the Acts of the Apostles (10:34, 37-43)

In those days, Peter spoke and said, "You know what happened in all Judea, which began in Galilee, after the baptism preached by John: How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the power of the Holy Spirit and how he went about doing good, healing all those oppressed by the devil, because God was with him. We are witnesses of all that he did in Judea and Jerusalem. They killed him by hanging him on the cross, but God raised him up on the third day and granted to see him, not all the people, but only the witnesses whom he had chosen beforehand: Us, who have eaten and drunk with him after he was raised from the dead. He commanded us to preach to the people and testify that God has made them judge of the living and the dead. The testimony of the prophets is unanimous: That all who believe in him receive through them the forgiveness of sins."

Word of God. We praise You, Lord.

Responsorial Psalm 117

R. This is the day of the Lord's triumph. Hallelujah.

We thank you, Lord, that you are good, because your mercy is eternal. Let the house of Israel say,

"His mercy endures forever." R.

The right hand of the Lord is mighty, the right hand of the Lord is our pride. I will not die, I will continue to live to tell what the Lord has done. R.

Second Reading

Seek the goods of heaven, where Christ is.

Reading from the Letter of the Apostle Paul to the Colossians (3:1-4)

Brothers and sisters, since you are risen with Christ, seek the things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Put all your heart on the goods of heaven, not on those of earth, for you have died and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ, your life, is manifested, then you too will manifest yourselves gloriously, together with him.

Holy Gospel

He was to rise from the dead.

Reading from the Holy Gospel according to Saint John (20, 1-9)

Glory to you, Lord.

The Empty Tomb - Early on the first day of the week, while it was still dark, Mary Magdalene went to the tomb and saw that the stone had been removed from the entrance. So, she came running to Simon Peter and the other disciple, the one Jesus loved, and said, "They have taken the Lord out of the tomb, and we don't know where they have put him!" So, Peter and the other disciple started for the tomb. Both were running, but the other disciple outran Peter and reached the tomb first. He bent over and looked in at the strips of linen lying there but did not go in. Then Simon Peter came along behind him and went straight into the tomb. He saw the strips of linen lying there, as well as the cloth that had been wrapped around Jesus' head. The cloth was still lying in its place, separate from the linen. Finally, the other disciple, who had reached the tomb first, also went inside. He saw and believed. (They still did not understand from Scripture that Jesus had to rise from the dead.)
