

Perfect

(pronounced pər'fekt)

“The LORD will **perfect** (pər'fekt) that which concerneth me: thy mercy, O LORD, endureth for ever: forsake not the works of thine own hands” (Psalm 138:7).

In this passage, the word perfect is pronounced pər'fekt and it is a verb because since it shows action is happening. The Biblical definition reads: make (something) completely free from faults or defects (mistakes!). The truth is, His sovereignty is constantly at work in your life transforming you, perfecting things that concern you, and changing you.

Everyone has issues and we are all born with defiant spirits. The problems you face daily will either defeat you or draw you closer to God and that all depends on how you respond. In life, you will always have things that are challenging you to trust Him.

Hosea 4:6, “My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. Because you have rejected knowledge, I also will reject you from being priest for Me; Because you have forgotten the law of your God...”

Forgotten indicates that something was once known. Furthermore, if you look at the structure of the verse, “rejected” knowledge means you are dismissing something or refusing to agree. Any way you look at it true wisdom and understanding begin with accepting the knowledge of God as truth.

Throughout life, there are times when you react foolishly or even resent the problems you encounter and yet somehow God finds a way to use them. That's why people perish! It's for lack of knowledge of walking in His Word. This also means the lack of depending on or knowing His Word!!! You are responsible for what you do or don't do. Trusting the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, and with that trust comes understanding/ knowledge of the Holy One.

The Lord wants to bring a dispensation of hope to you today with the truth of His Word. He is reminding you to be confident in the midst of mistakes or trials. He is telling you beyond a shadow of doubt that He will perfect that which concerns you. Are you concerned about something? He will pər'fekt it.

Say it out loud!!!! “He will pər'fekt that which concerns me!” (Psalm 138:7).

There's no doubt that you want things to take place on your time table. Unfortunately, when those things don't occur, you tend to make other decisions that lead you into unhealthy areas, stress, or other ungodly things. You have to remind yourself in the mistake of life that God is in control, that He is sovereign and He will do whatever He said He would. Today's message is a reminder to walk in His power for He will indeed complete His work in you and He is making you **free** from faults of defects. He will carry you through. He will bring you to completion. He will achieve all He has planned for you.

God will accomplish everything within you. He will execute it and oversee it. He is carrying you through with HIS glorious process. He will bring you to completion. He is the one who does it. God is the one who initiates the work of redemption in your life (Ephesians 1:14). God will bring His work (you) to completion.

God is not dependent on the whims of chance to accomplish His plans in you, He always finishes what He starts. It's so important to remember the truth regardless life's circumstances, that "He never fails" (Zephaniah 3:5) and it's impossible for God to lie (Hebrews 6:18). God is all powerful. He is abundantly abundant. He is all sufficient. He is productive and He an ever Presence.

Even when things seem to be impossible, God can take the impossible thing and turns it something incredible. He is more than enough. You can trust Him. God cannot go back on His word. My precious friends- the Lord will fulfill His purposes for you. His love is eternal, and He will never abandon the work of His hands (that means you!).
