- The race will begin at 8 a.m. The Fun Run will begin at 8:30 a.m. Awards will be announced at 9:30 a.m.
- You can park in the GSU RAC parking lot or Pavilion parking lot. Go to www.pinkpowerrun.com for a map of parking available near the venue.

- We ask for all volunteers to help with setup and clean-up for the event. If you have time before your scheduled task begins, please offer a hand to other volunteers when needed.
