Some of the physical sufferings of Jesus Christ prophesied and fulfilled.

Ps 129:3 The plowers plowed upon my back: they made long their furrows.

Jn 19:1 Then Pilate therefore took Jesus, and **scourged** *him*.

Isa 50:6 I gave my **back to the smiters**, and my cheeks to them that plucked off the hair: I hid not my **face from shame and spitting**.

Mt 27:30 And they **spit upon him**, and took the reed, and smote him on the head.

Isa 52:14 As many were astonished at thee; his **visage was so marred** more than any man, and his form more than the sons of men:

Lk 22:64 And when they had blindfolded him, **they struck him on the face**, and asked him, saying, Prophecy, who is it that smote thee?

Isa 53:5 But he *was* wounded for our transgressions, *he was* bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace *was* upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

Ps 22:16 For dogs have compassed me: the assembly of the wicked have inclosed me: **they pierced my hands and my feet**.

Mk 15:25 And it was the third hour, and they **crucified him**.

Jn 20:25 The other disciples therefore said unto him, We have seen the Lord. But he said unto them, Except I shall see in his hands **the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails**, and thrust my hand into his side, I will not believe.

Zec 12:10 And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: **and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced**, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for *his* only *son*, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for *his* firstborn.

Jn 19:34 But one of the soldiers with a **spear pierced his side**, and forthwith came there out blood and water.

The following verse is in view of the destruction of Jerusalem but note the 1<sup>st</sup> person singular application. “done unto **me**,” “**my** sorrow” “afflicted **me**” would there be an application to that “righteous man on the cross?”

La 1:12 *Is it* nothing to you, all ye that pass by? behold, and see if there be any sorrow like unto my sorrow, which is done unto me, wherewith the LORD hath afflicted *me* in the day of his fierce anger.
