

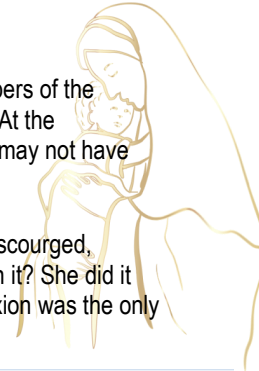


May 15, 2022 Fifth Sunday of Easter
